C. PROJECT CONTENT and ORGANISATION

1. What are the <u>concrete aims</u> of the project and its <u>expected impact</u> on the participants and other interested parties (on the pupils, teachers, institutions, local community, wider educational community)?

General <u>aims</u> are: use of ICT, project based learning, co operative learning, autonomous learning, use of foreign languages, co operation through ICT.

<u>Concrete aim</u> of the project is to exchange information about educational systems and school life, to compare it and to transfer useful pedagogical methods and strategies to improve learning. Teachers and pupils are going to be informed about European schools and enhance their knowledge about school systems, curriculum, school activities, methods, facilities, books, practices and so on.

<u>Impact.</u> Teachers, pupils and institutions are going to use foreign languages and ICT as tools to communicate and to organise a project. Moreover, they will learn about other cultures and they will have a better understanding of their partners in order to accept the differences and similarities between the different nations.

Local community and wider educational community are going to be informed about the content of the project as well as about the methods of co operation. The end products will be a chance to learn about educational systems in Europe.

Every participant is going to improve his/her awareness of community identity and European dimension, his knowledge on foreign languages and ICT. Also, everyone will get experience and useful co operative/communicative skills on working with fellows from other countries.

2. Which activities do you intend to carry out in the course of the project?

Please provide a general overview of the activities planned for the whole project duration (i.e. max. 3 years for a School or School Development Project; max.2 years for a Language Project). FIRST YEAR.

Correspondence and e-mail communication among participant pupils.

Production and exchange of material about country, region, town, school and educational systems.

Project meeting in July 2007 for evaluation of first year, presentation of material and planning for school year 2007-08.

Educational visits of co ordinator teachers to partner schools in order to know each other better.

SECOND YEAR

Production and exchange of material about school buildings, classes, subjects, excursions, festivities, holidays, books, facilities, extra activities, social life, projects, educational software and so on.

3. What kind of end product(s) do you intend to produce?

Booklet with information and comparison of educational systems and schools.

Cd rom or dvd with school environment, festivities and excursions.

Booklet with school subjects and translated material to be used by all partner schools.

Exhibition/ Activities in the schools involved. T-shirts with names of partner schools (They can be in different colours and we can put the pictures of every partner school on). Competitions of picture, song, composition and poetry about the school ad school life.

Website with information about the project (text, sound, illustrations, drawings) – it will be easy to reach from all over the world.

4. How do you intend to <u>evaluate</u> the <u>progress</u> of the project and its <u>impact</u> on the participating pupils and teachers, the participating institutions and, where relevant, on the local community?

Evaluation of the *progress* will be monitored informally during all the process through production of material, cooperation and e-mail exchange among pupils, communication and exchange of materials between participant teachers. Ways of evaluation: questionnaires, reports, quizzes. Also, co ordinator teachers will use unified questionnaires to evaluate participants' opinions or suggestions about future activities.

<u>Impact</u> of the project will be evaluated by the number of participants or would-be participant teachers and pupils. Evaluation will be done through questionnaire /suggestion reports for participant and not participant teachers / pupils.

5. How do you intend to <u>disseminate</u> the results, experience and end products amongst the participating institutions, other institutions and the local community?

<u>Informal dissemination</u>. Participant teachers, pupils and institutions will disseminate the results in their fellows by discussing about their experiences during the project.

<u>Formal dissemination</u>. We plan to publish information in pupils' newspapers, in local press, in educational magazines. Also, to produce material (posters) for exhibition at schools. Another idea is to produce a leaflet to be send to other schools and authorities or to hold a presentation day about the project that will be open to the public. Lastly, project material will be reproduced along with being available to everyone through the website.

6. What kind of <u>specific</u> measures, <u>if any</u>, do you intend to take within the project to:

facilitate the participation of pupils with special educational needs?

Pupils with special educational needs or learning difficulties can participate in "easy" school subjects Comenius groups like Sports or in extra curricular activities. Also, project activities do not require a high intellectual level, just creativity and imagination.

ensure equal opportunities for the participation of female and male pupils and staff?

Since the project covers all curriculum subjects there will be equal opportunities for male and female to participate in the group that is closer to their interests and skills. The activities are flexible and do not respond to stereotype sex roles.

promote intercultural education, and/or to help combat racism/xenophobia?

Intercultural education will be promoted through exchange of information among pupils and teachers about their school systems and school life. Also since all project activities include interaction, they will offer the opportunity to participants to learn about other cultures, to be friends with people from different social, national, family background and to become familiar with diversity. Moreover, since Turkey and Greece as well as other countries are in this project, we think that we have the chance of showing our students that we are not enemies but we look like each other more than everyone. Also, because there are pupils who are children of migrant workers at many schools, learning about other countries and their people, will increase pupils' awareness of diversity. As a result, difference and diversity won't be considered as reason for racism /xenophobia but as source of variety.

facilitate the participation of pupils/schools who/which are disadvantaged for socio-economic or other reasons?

Some of partner schools are disadvantaged because of geographical reasons. They are far away from capital city or sea is an obstacle for transportation. (For example, Greek school is on Rodos island, which although a favourite tourist destination, is very far away from the capital and the sea is an obstacle for communication). The majority of our pupils have never been to the capital nor have they contact with pupils from other schools because it is very expensive to travel to the mainland and they are too young and inexperienced to travel alone.

facilitate the participation of disabled pupils and staff?

Since the project will be integrated in all school subjects, any teacher is free and welcome to participate. Also, pupils will have the opportunity to choose among ten subjects Comenius groups according to their interests and skills.

enhance the participation of pupils from ethnic and other minority groups, in particular children of migrant workers, gypsies, travellers and occupational travellers?

At partner schools there are a lot of pupils who are children of minority groups (for example: in Greek school there are children of migrant workers who can easily get a job in Rodos because of tourist development. Istanbul is a cosmopolitan city and there are many people from different ethnics and different places. So pupils from all different groups participate.). Those pupils will have the same opportunities to participate in the project and to see that diversity is a common characteristic all around Europe. Also because of their different cultural and social background they will be more motivated and interested in the union of different cultures from different countries.

7. Please describe the role of all participating institutions and explain how an effective cooperation and distribution of tasks will be ensured.

All partner institutions will have the same responsibility and the same tasks regarding production of material, arrangement of educational visits, monitoring pupils' communication and so on. Co ordinator school will monitor material production, keeping the schedule, planning activities and material to be exchanged per year. Also there will be a common framework about the material that has to be produced and exchanged so that all school more or less produce the same quantity and quality.

Teacher and pupil mobility among partner institutions will enhance interpersonal relations among participants and it will promote effective co operation.

8. Does the project intend to use information and communication technologies? If yes, what kind of technologies? How and to what extent will they be used?

ICT is going to be an integral part of the project.

<u>*E-mail*</u> will be used for communication among institutions, teachers and pupils since it is fast and cheap. Another idea is to use <u>chat and forum or videoconference</u> for communication and co operation. xchange of material will be in electronic form.

Software like <u>WORD, EXCEL, PUBLISHER, POWERPOINT</u> will be used for production and presentation of end products.

<u>Internet</u> will be used for searching material and creation of <u>websites</u> will be used for dissemination of the project. We plan to consult existing Comenius networks like Comp@ct or PROMISE and to create ejournal through the help of these networks.

Lastly, we may use Computer Supported Collaborative Learning systems for synchronous communication.

9. How will the project ensure the active participation of pupils throughout the project (planning, implementation and evaluation)?

Pupils will have a wide choice of topics since all school subjects as well as extra activities are included. During planning they can decide what kind of information about their school they want to exchange. E-mail and making new friends will add personal meaning to the project. Implementation of the project through ICT is appealing to pupils since new technologies are used. Evaluation will be important for pupils since the project will be their own work.

10. How will the project be integrated into the curriculum of the pupils participating in the project at the institutions involved?

All school subjects will be included with a variety of topics. Each teacher will work with a group of 10 pupils. Basic project activities will be integrated in regular classes, as an extension of the lesson. For example, basic information about country can be prepared in Geography classes,

translated in English classes and then presented electronically in Computer classes. In Composition or Literature lessons, the project result can be presented and evaluated by the students. Email exchange between pupils can be done in English classes. Exchange of school textbook material can be done in every subject.

Project activities involve cross curricular topics so teachers of different subjects can participate by integrating the project into the curriculum.
