

War World 1: the debilitating terms of the Paris Peace Treaty humiliated German



1917: RUSSIA BECAME THE SOVIET UNION (USSR), THE FIRST SOCIALIST STATE APPEALED TO MANY DISAPPOINTED EUROPEANS \rightarrow FEAR OF THE SPREAD OF COMMUNISM ABROAD



 ● February of 1929: the financial crisis in USA negatively affected the economies around the World →caused insecurity in societies worldwide



BIRTH OF FASCISM IN ITALY (BENITO MUSSOLINI) AND NAZISM IN GERMANY (ADOLF HITLER)


nationalism anti-communism absolutism devaluation of democracy



Italy: extermination of political opponents


Germany: extermination of political opponents, homosexuals, gypsies, disabled, Jews

On the eve of the World War 2 all European states have fascist regimes





- 1936 1937: Pact of Germany-Japan-Italy against communism and in favour of fascism throughout the world
- 1937: Germany-Italy Axis



THE WAR IS COMING

- 1938: Germany occupied Austria
- 1939: Germany occupied Czechoslovakia
- 1939: Italy occupied Albania



THE BEGINNING OF THE WAR

- September 1939: German invasion of Poland
- The British and French declared war on Germany
- The Germans successively conquered Denmark, the Netherlands, Luxembourg, Norway, Belgium, France
- Unsuccessful German air attacks on Great Britain



October 28, 1940: Italy demanded the surrender of Greece

Ioannis Metaxas (prime minister): OCHI (NO)



 Italian invasion of Northern Greece through Albania



 The Greek army defeated the Italians and liberated many Albanian cities



THE BALKANS

- Bulgaria: ally of Germans and Italians
- Spring of 1941: Germans conquered Yugoslavia
- April 6, 1941: German attack on Greece





Japan vs Southeast Asia countries and USA in the Pacific Ocean



- June 22, 1941: German invasion of the Soviet Union
- ●Two years struggle→ the Germans did not achieved their goal
- 1943: the Germans were defeated in Stalingrad: The beginning of the end





- after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor (Hawaii), December 7, 1941
- Catalyst in the outcome of the war
- Economic and military superpower



•6 June 1944: Allied seaborne invasion of Normandy

- Americans, British, French→ Berlin from the West
- \odot Soviets \rightarrow Berlin from the East






THE END OF THE WAR

- October 12, 1944: German withdrawal from Greece
- August 1945: atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki→ surrender of Japan
- September 2, 1945: surrender of Germany
