





SIGHTSEEING GAME AROUND OSTRZESZÓW



Game points:

1. Tower. The beginning of the construction of the castle as a fortification was in the 14th century during the reign of Casimir the Great. The five-story and 24 meters tall tower was a watchtower and a residential tower as well as a tower of final defense.

TASKS: target archery, tour of the Tower, binocular orienteering exercise

 Museum/town hall. The oldest historical mention of the town of Ostrzeszów dates back to 1283. The wooden town hall was erected in the 18th century, and the existing brick town hall was built in 1840.

TASKS: medieval paper making, museum visit

3. Scouts' monument. A monument in honor of Ostrzeszów scouts who died in the fight for Poland's independence, unveiled in 1984, during the jubilee celebrations of the 70th anniversary of scouting in the Ostrzeszów region.

TASKS: scout singing and dancing

4. **Post-Bernardine monastery** from the 17th century funded by the local landowners.

TASKS: tour of the monastery, solving the BINGO game during the tour

5. The oldest catholic church in town. The parish of the Blessed Virgin Mary of the Assumption was built in the 14th century and was funded by Casimir the Great. Frescoes and Gothic stained glass windows decorate the church.

TASKS: matching historical figures and monuments learnt with their descriptions written in mirror image.

6. During World War II, the Nazis established a prisoner of war camp on our school premises, where mainly foreigners were held. From October 9, 1939 to December 8, 1939 a religious brother, Maksymilian Maria Kolbe was imprisoned here. He died in 1941, giving his life for a fellow inmate in the Auschwitz death camp. He is considered a martyr and saint of the Catholic Church.

TASKS: Escape room

Upon completion of each task, participants were awarded points. the group with the most points won.
