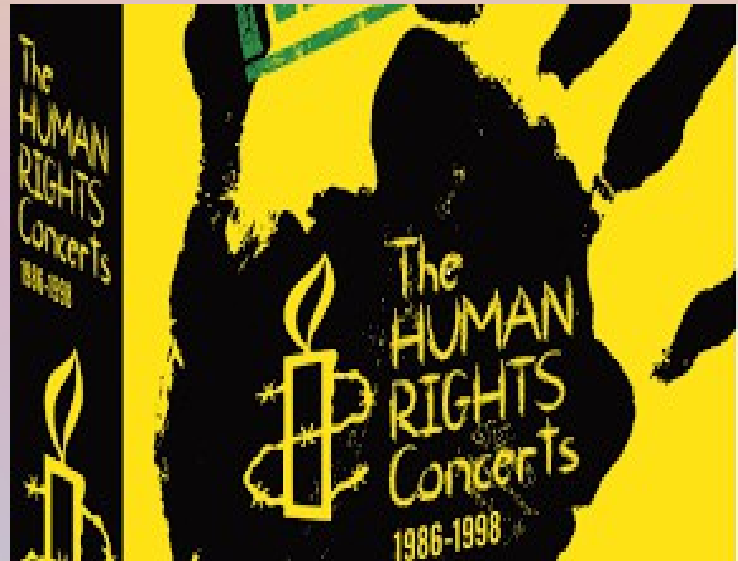
# Campaign for Human Rights
