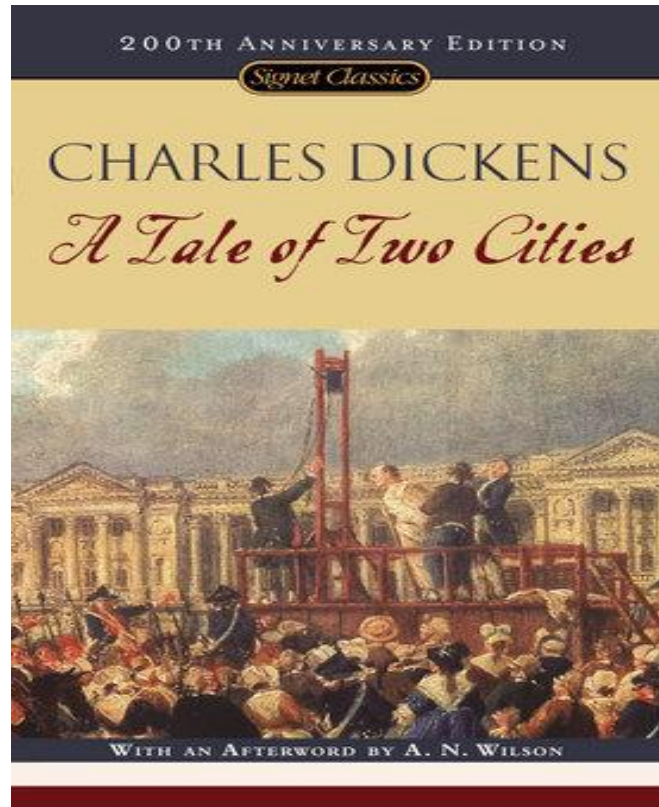


A TALE OF TWO CITIES
