Julia Stoner




Helen's twin sister. Her death forms the basis of the story.

A useless bell rope, never created for its original use, a ventilator connecting two rooms with each other rather than with the outside, a bed never meant to be moved, a sudden whistle every night at 3 o' clock, and a house full of dangerous animals are the clues that Holmes is called to examine.

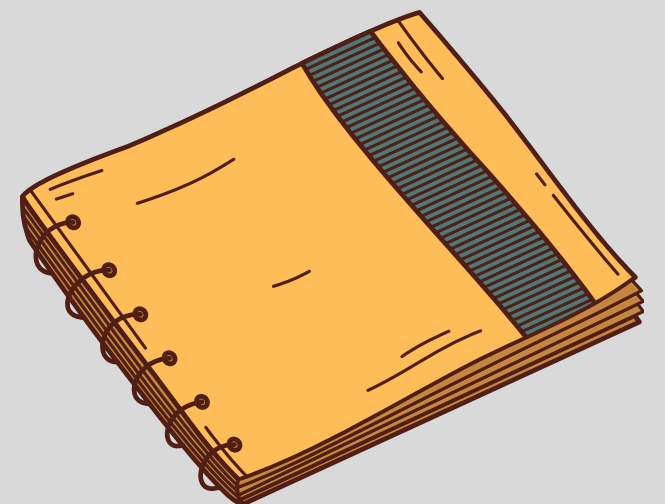
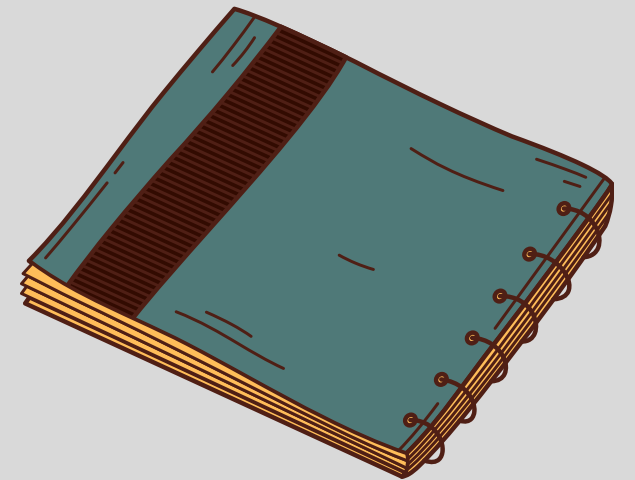
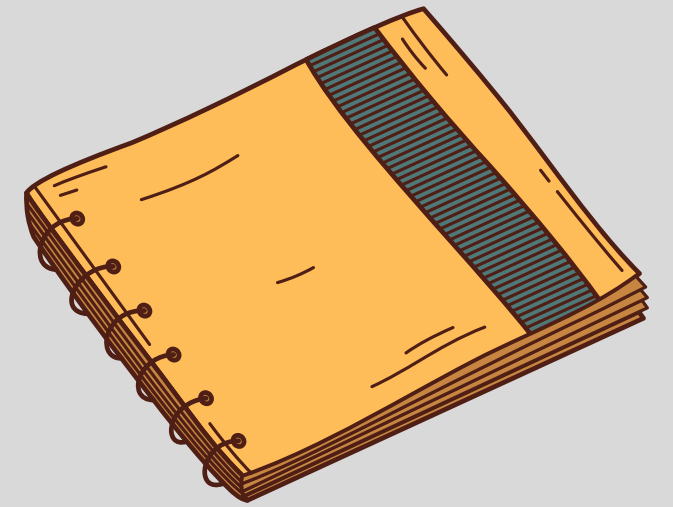
