Christodoulos Galtemis is a Greek painter and engraver from Ioannina. He was an associate professor of the School of Fine Arts at the University of Ioannina. He was born in 1953 in Kostaniani, Ioannina. A student already in secondary education, he took his first painting lessons with the Gianniotis painter Georgios Kazakos. He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts of Athens, in the engraving workshop of Kostas Grammatopoulos from where he graduated with the distinction "Prize for artistic works". He also attended, while studying, the "Artistic Typography and Book Art Workshop".





# His work

- In his works he gives views from neighborhoods of old Athens from residential and non-neoclassical houses as well as from traditional provincial houses. Works by Galtemis can be found in the Educational Foundation of the National Bank, the Labor Bank, the European Investment Bank, the Vorre Museum, the Evangelos Averof Gallery in Metsovo, the Town Hall of Ioannina, the Engraving Gallery founded by Costas Malamos in Zitsa, Ioannina. Also at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, at the Hyatt Regency Thessaloniki and King George Athens hotels. Also in banks, public organizations and in many private collections in Greece, Cyprus, USA, Canada, England, Belgium, France, Germany. He has 19 individual exhibitions to his credit and took part in numerous group exhibitions.
