CHARLES DICKENS LIFE

- *He was born on 7 February 1812 in Landport in Portsea island .*
- *As a kid he spend time outdoors but he also liked to read voraciously . He read and read the Arabian Nights.*
- *He didn't have a good life as a kid, as in the age of 15 he was forced to leave school and work ten-hours to pay for his board and to help his family*
- *Charles retained poignant memories of childhood, helped by an excellent memory of people and events, which he used in his writing*
- *Every station in his life professional, family, romantic had a clear influence on his works.*
- *He died on on 9 June 1870 in England.*

CHARLES DICKENS CARRIER

- ◉ *He was regraded by many as the greatest English novelist and social critic, who created some of the world's best-known fictional characters*
- ◉ *Dickens edited a weekly journal for 20 years, wrote 15 novels, five novellas, hundreds of short stories and non-fiction articles*
- ◉ *His literary success began with the serial publication of "The Pickwick Papers"*
- ◉ *His 1843 novella *A Christmas carol* remains especially popular and continues to inspire many creators.*
- ◉ *His plots were carefully constructed and he often wove elements from topical events into his narratives.*
