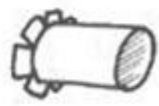




Head: Stuff 1/3 of paper bag. Tie stuffed end with string.

Scarf: Apply glue to tab A. Overlap side A on top of tab A.

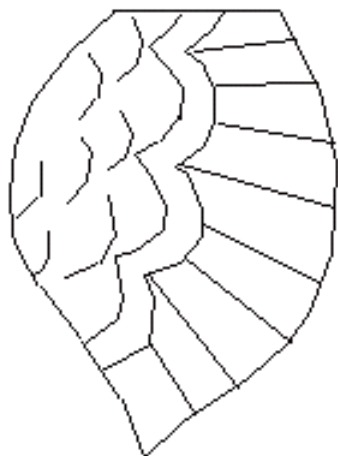

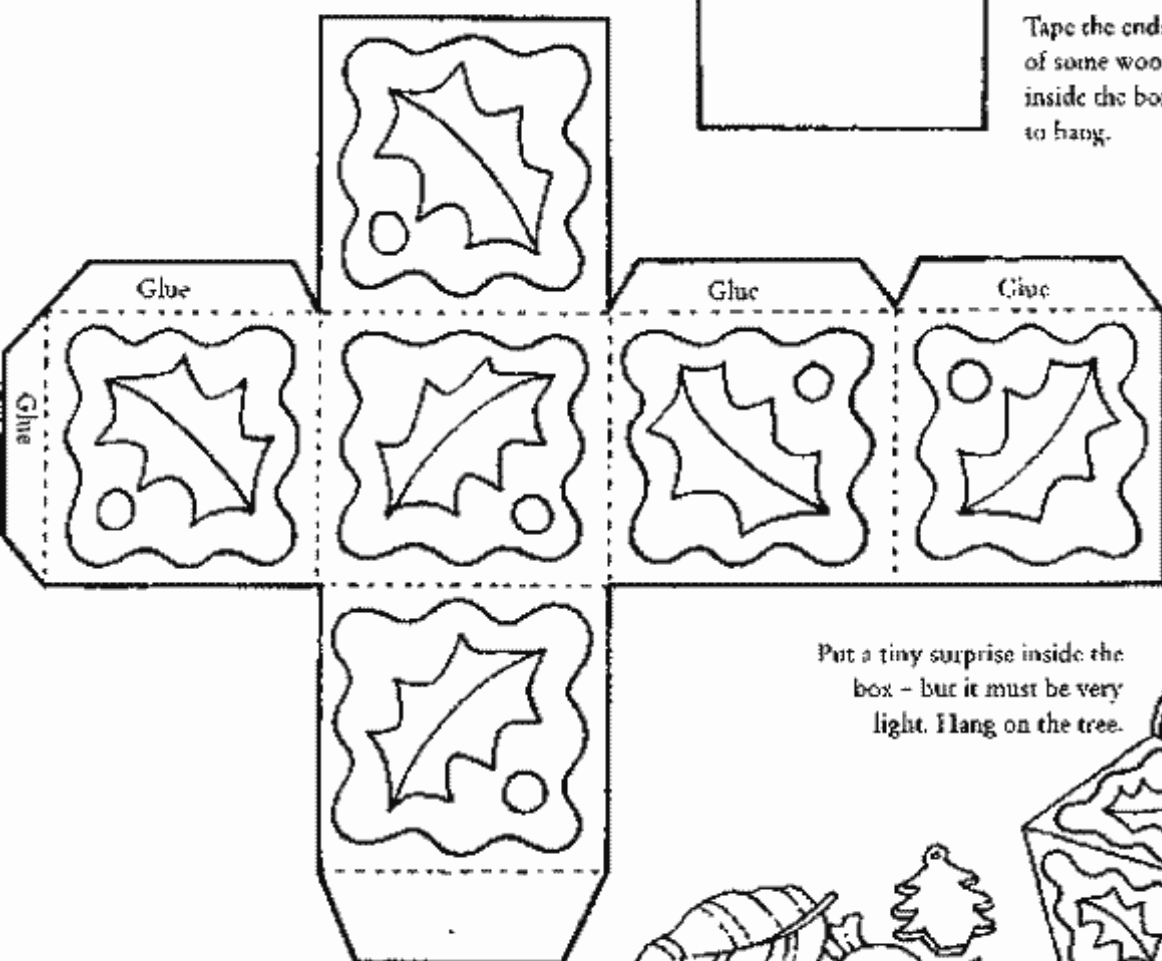


Christmas boxes

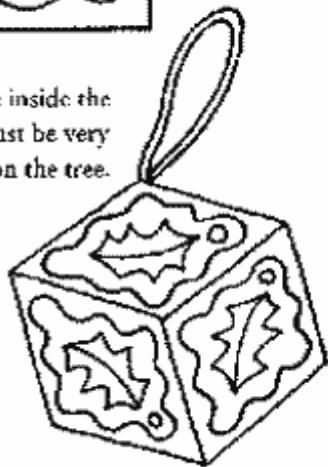
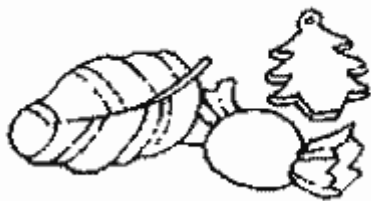
Colour the box. Cut out and fold it carefully along the dotted lines. Glue where marked and make into a box. Press glued edges together well.

Put a tiny surprise inside the box - but it must be very light. Hang on the tree.

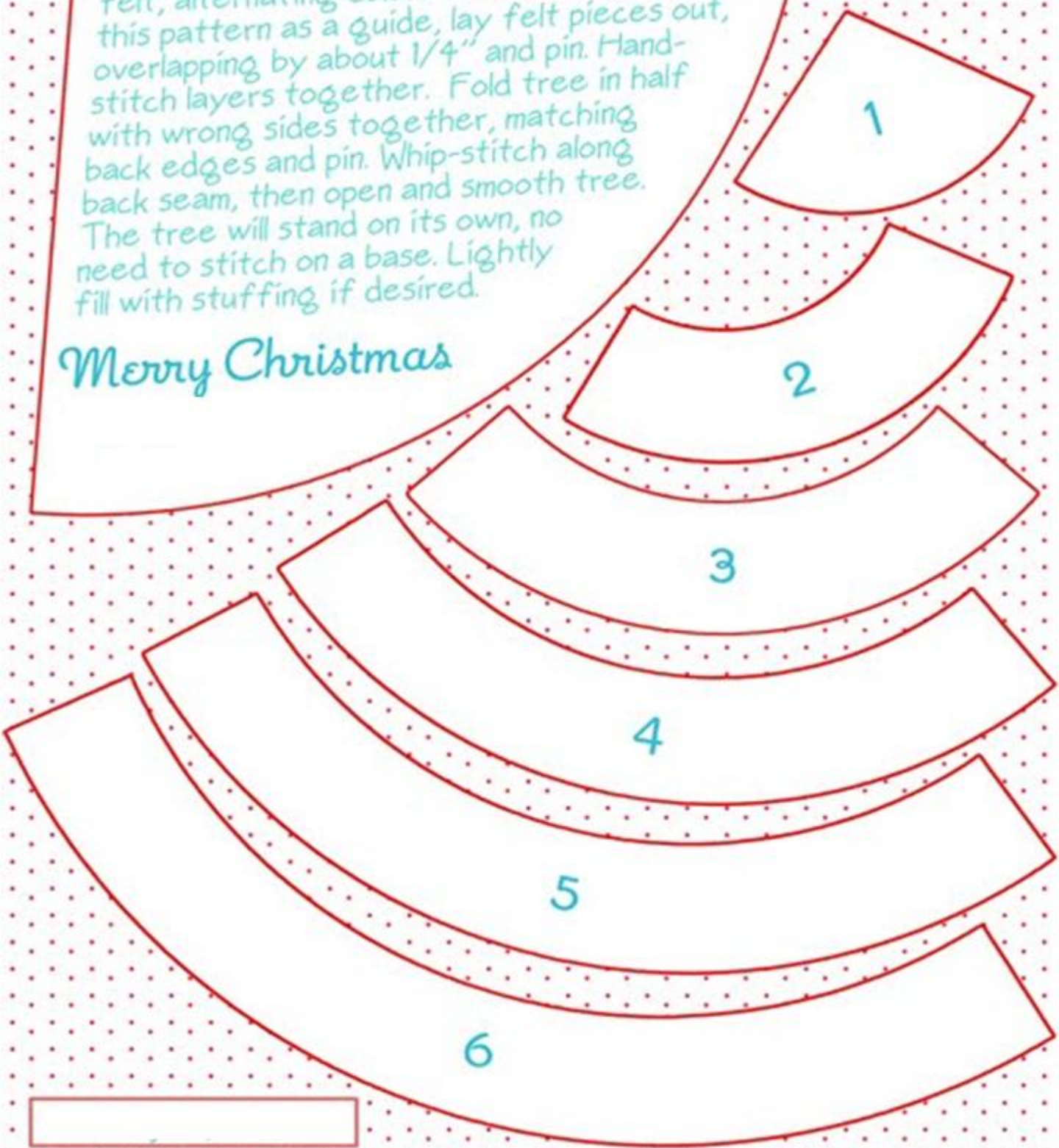


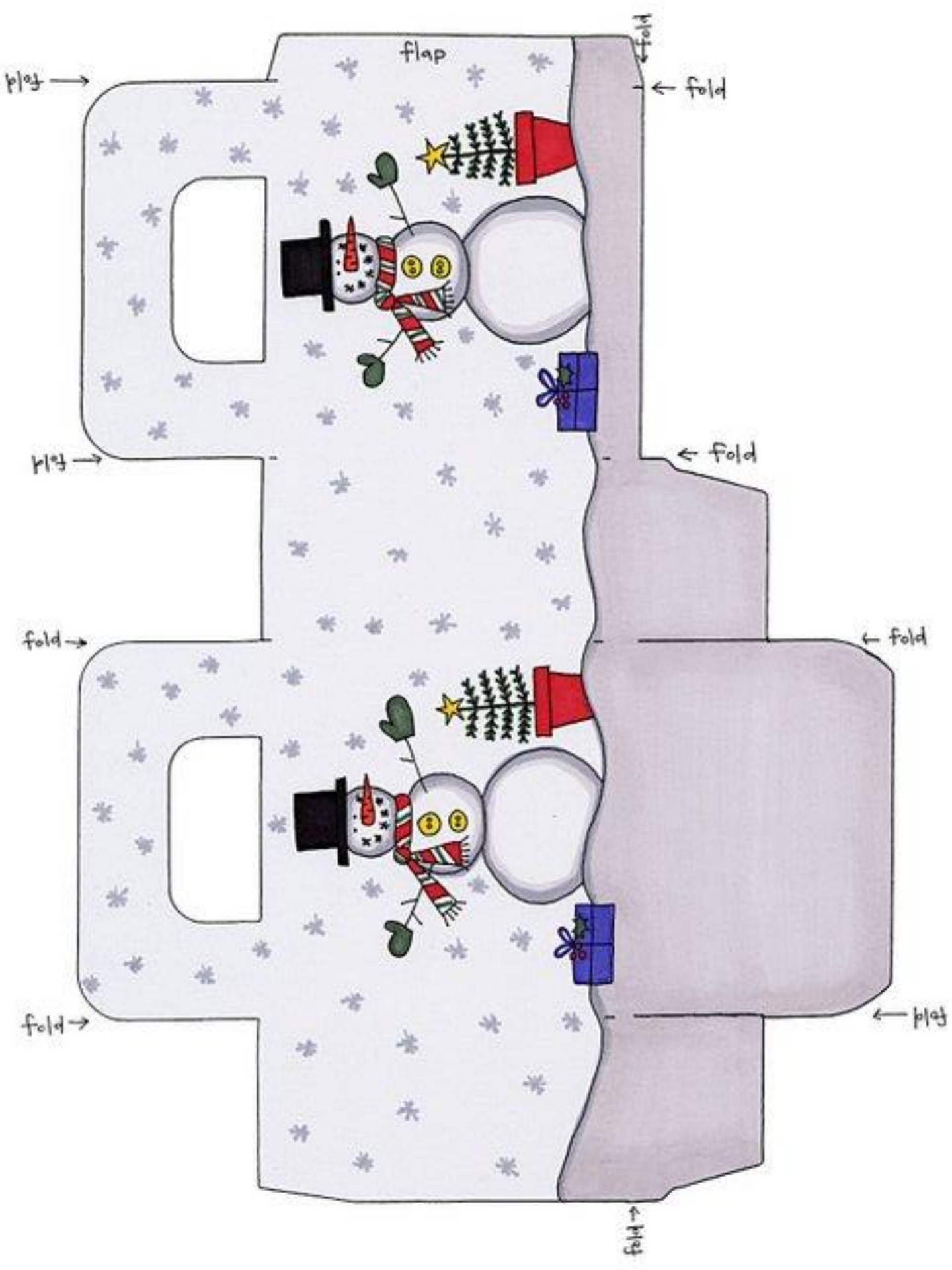
Festive Felt Trees

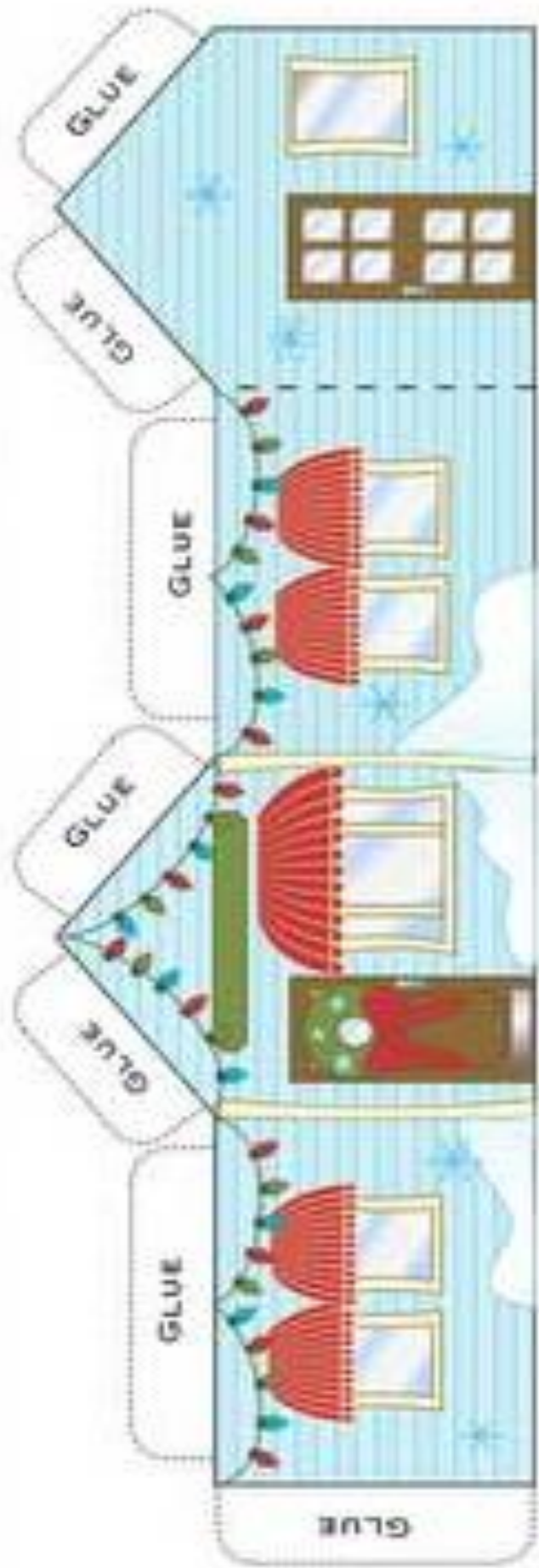

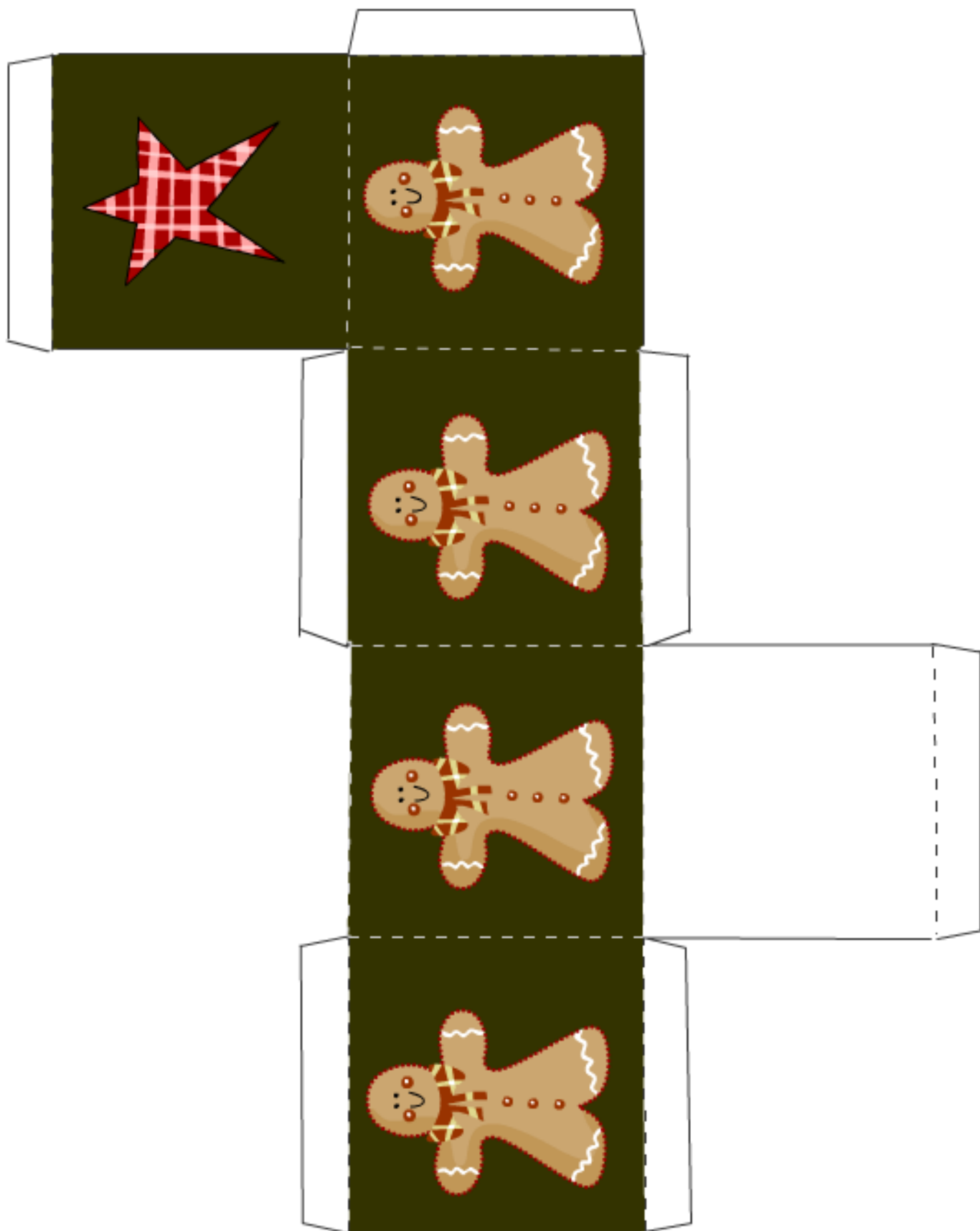
Use pattern pieces on other page to cut felt, alternating colors for each layer. With this pattern as a guide, lay felt pieces out, overlapping by about 1/4" and pin. Hand-stitch layers together. Fold tree in half with wrong sides together, matching back edges and pin. Whip-stitch along back seam, then open and smooth tree. The tree will stand on its own, no need to stitch on a base. Lightly fill with stuffing if desired.

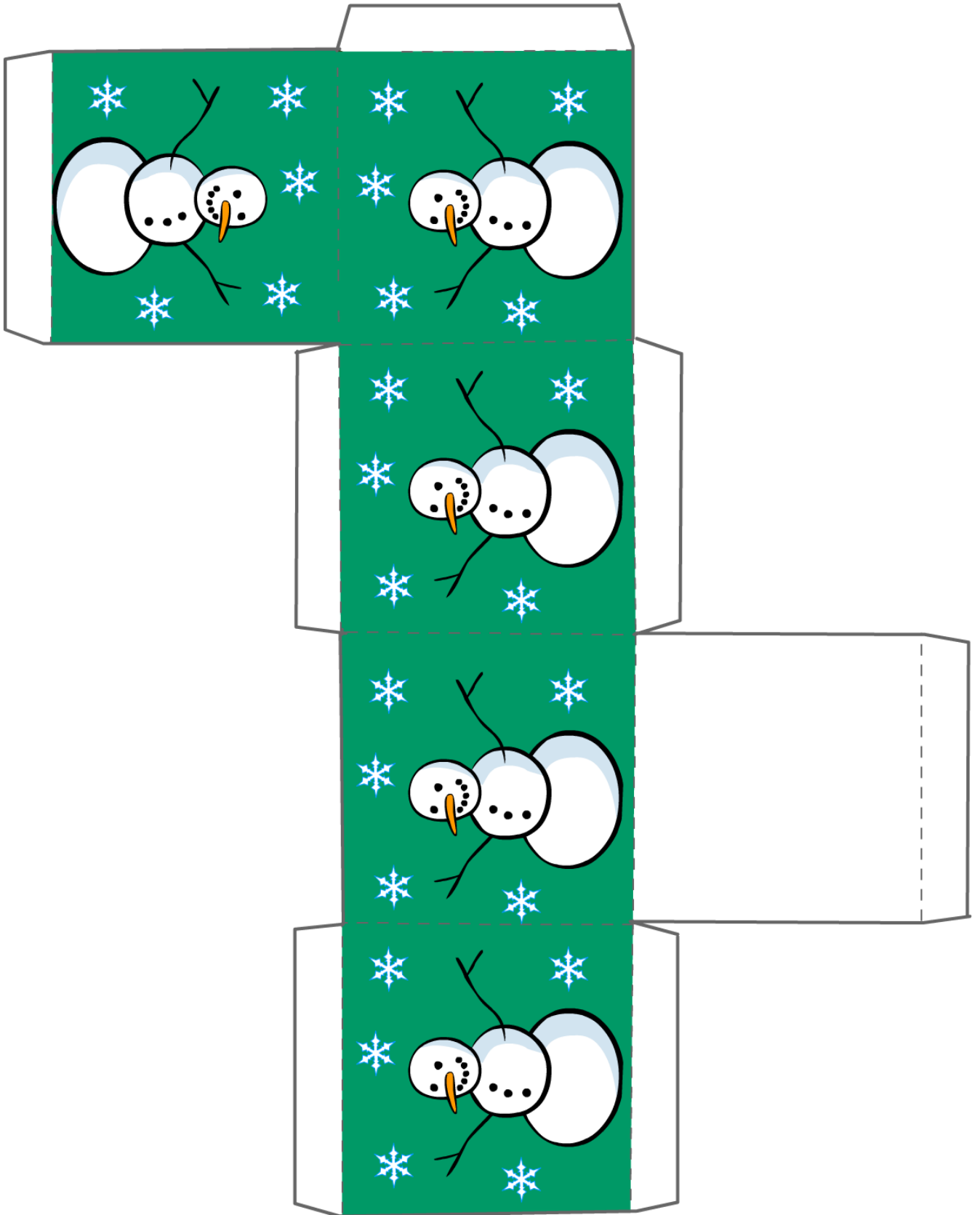

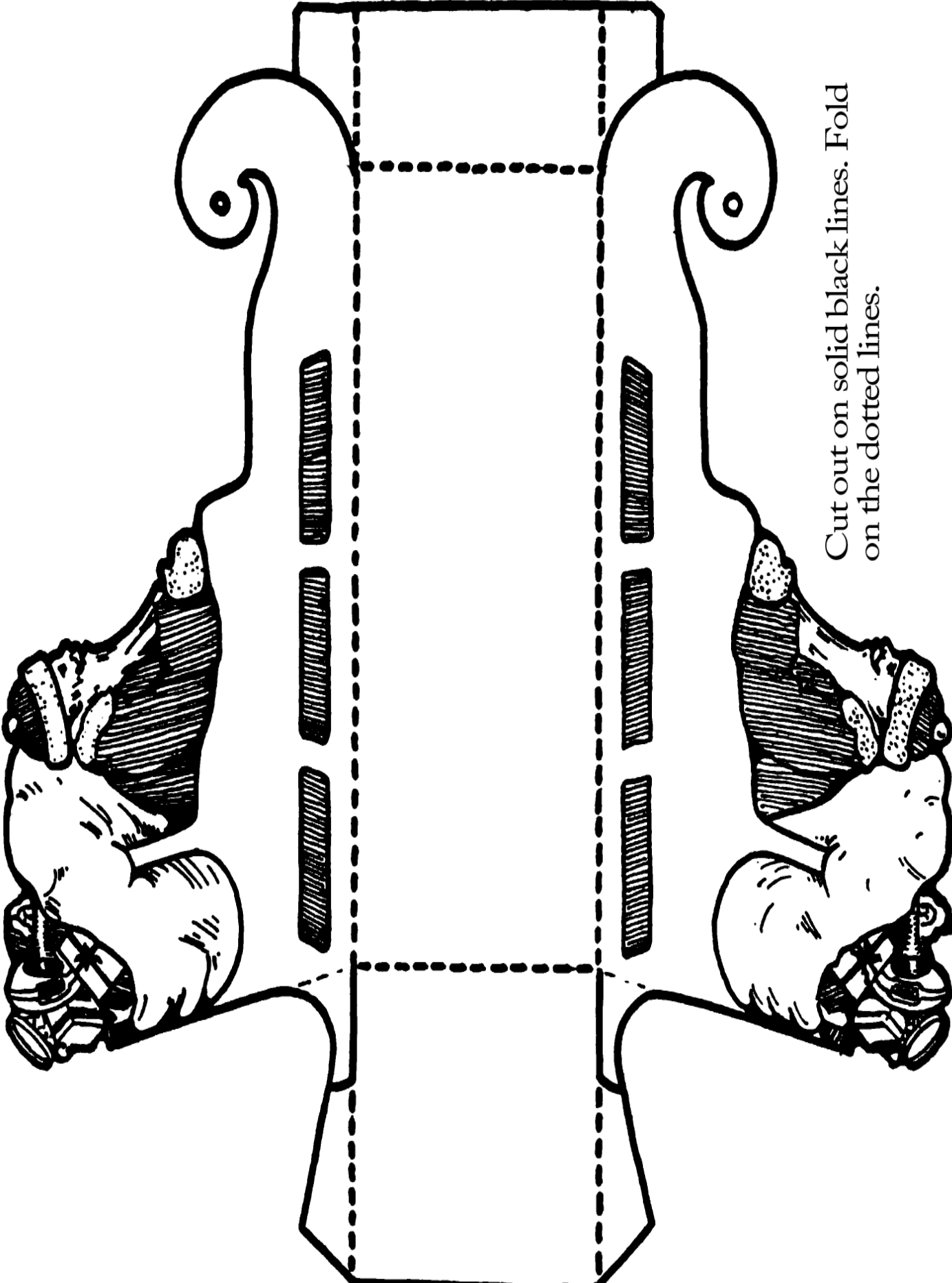


THE Completed Chimney

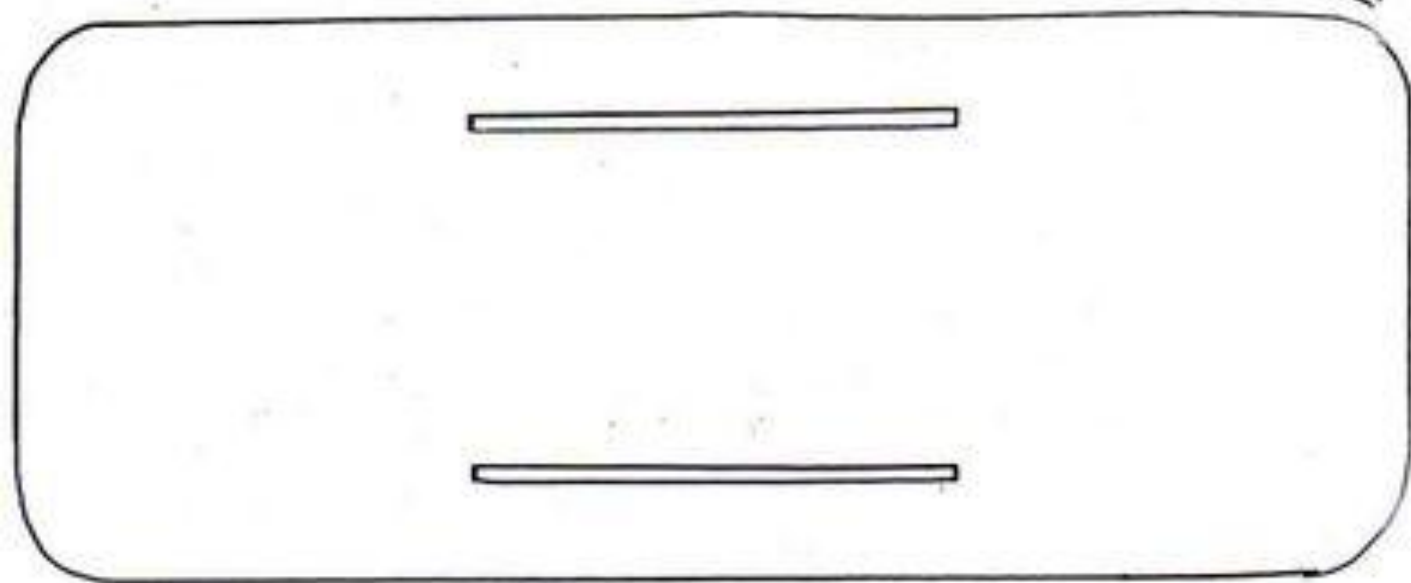
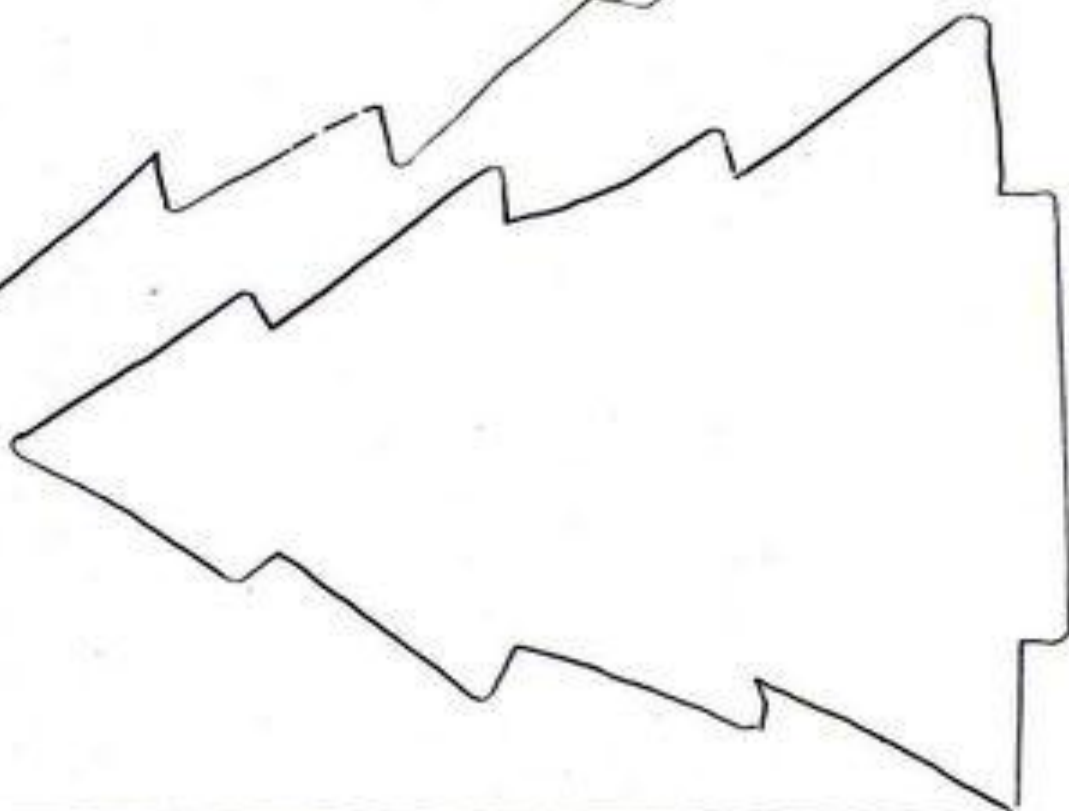
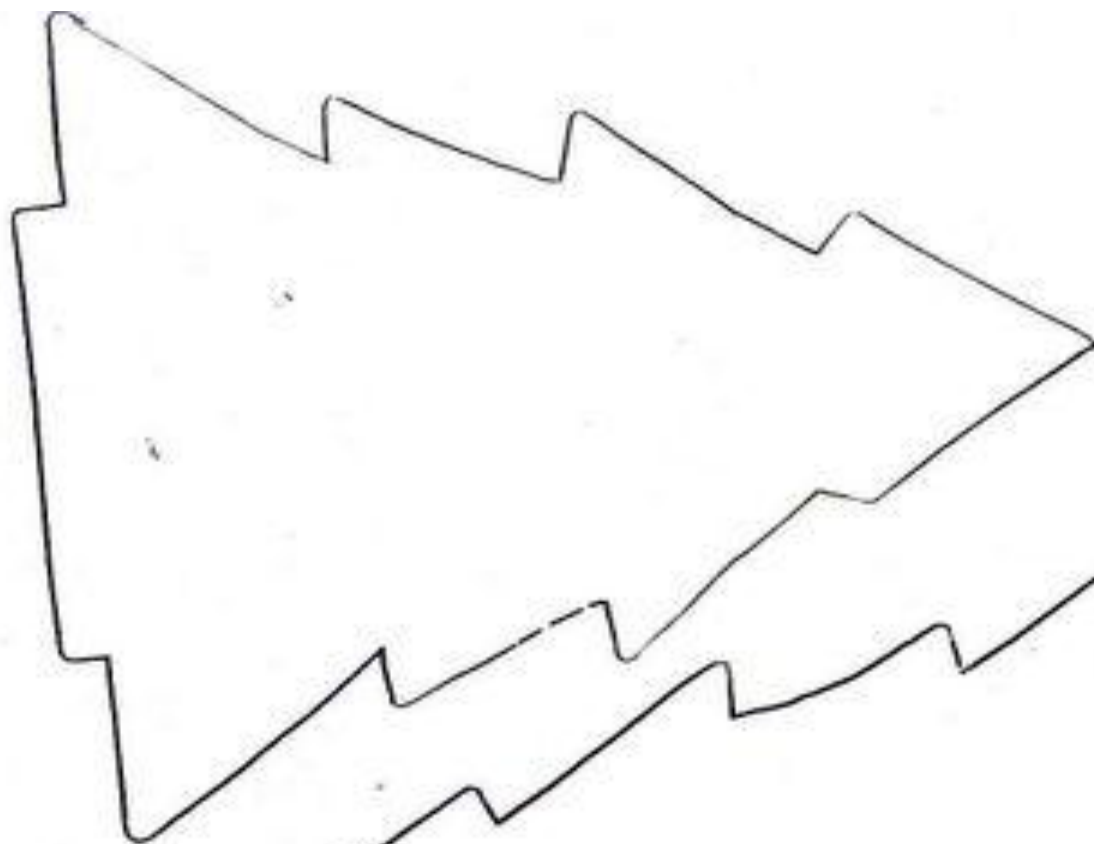

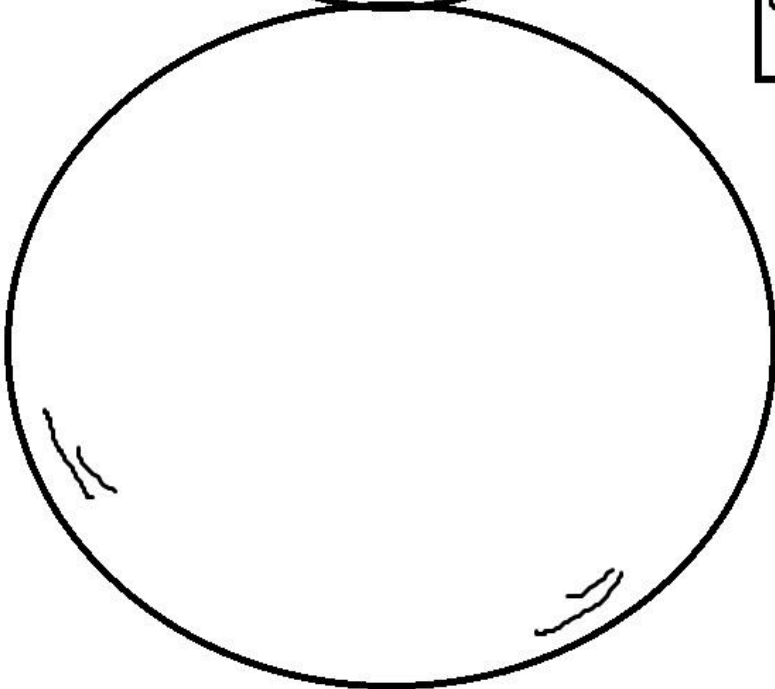
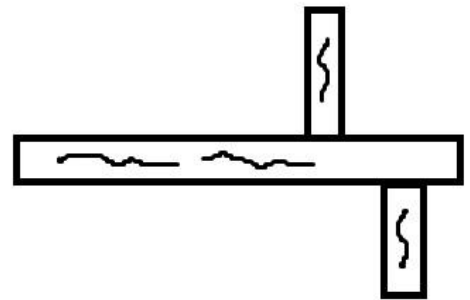
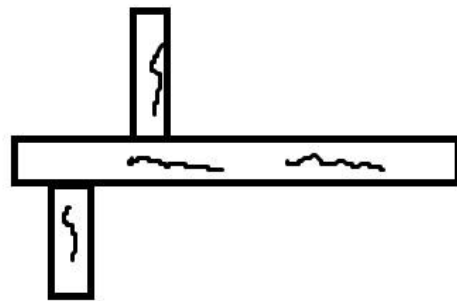
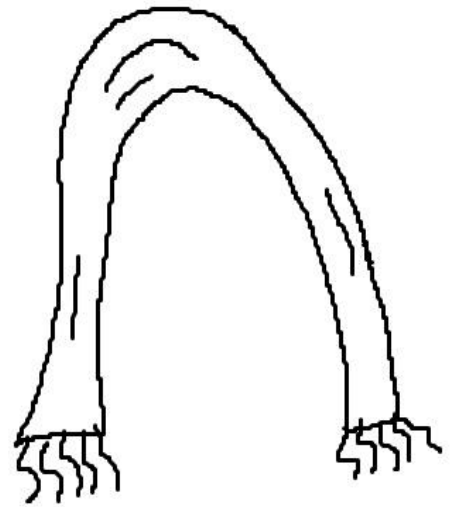
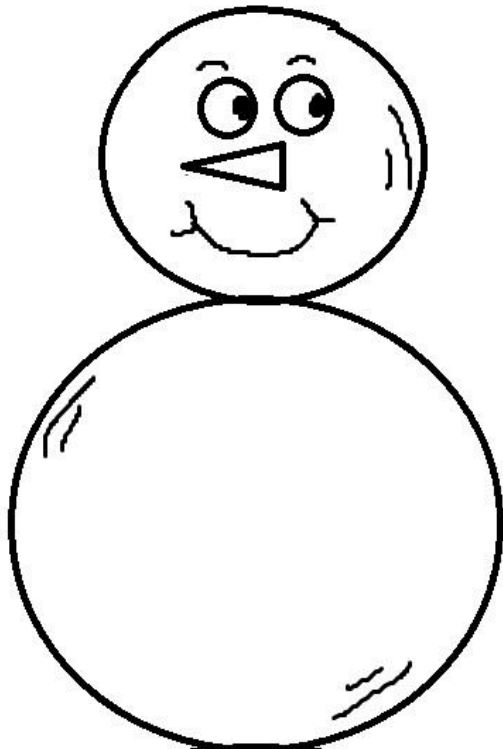




Cut out on solid black lines. Fold on the dotted lines.



Cut everything out. Glue your snowman to a piece of construction paper. Glue your hat, scarf, buttons and arms to your snowman.

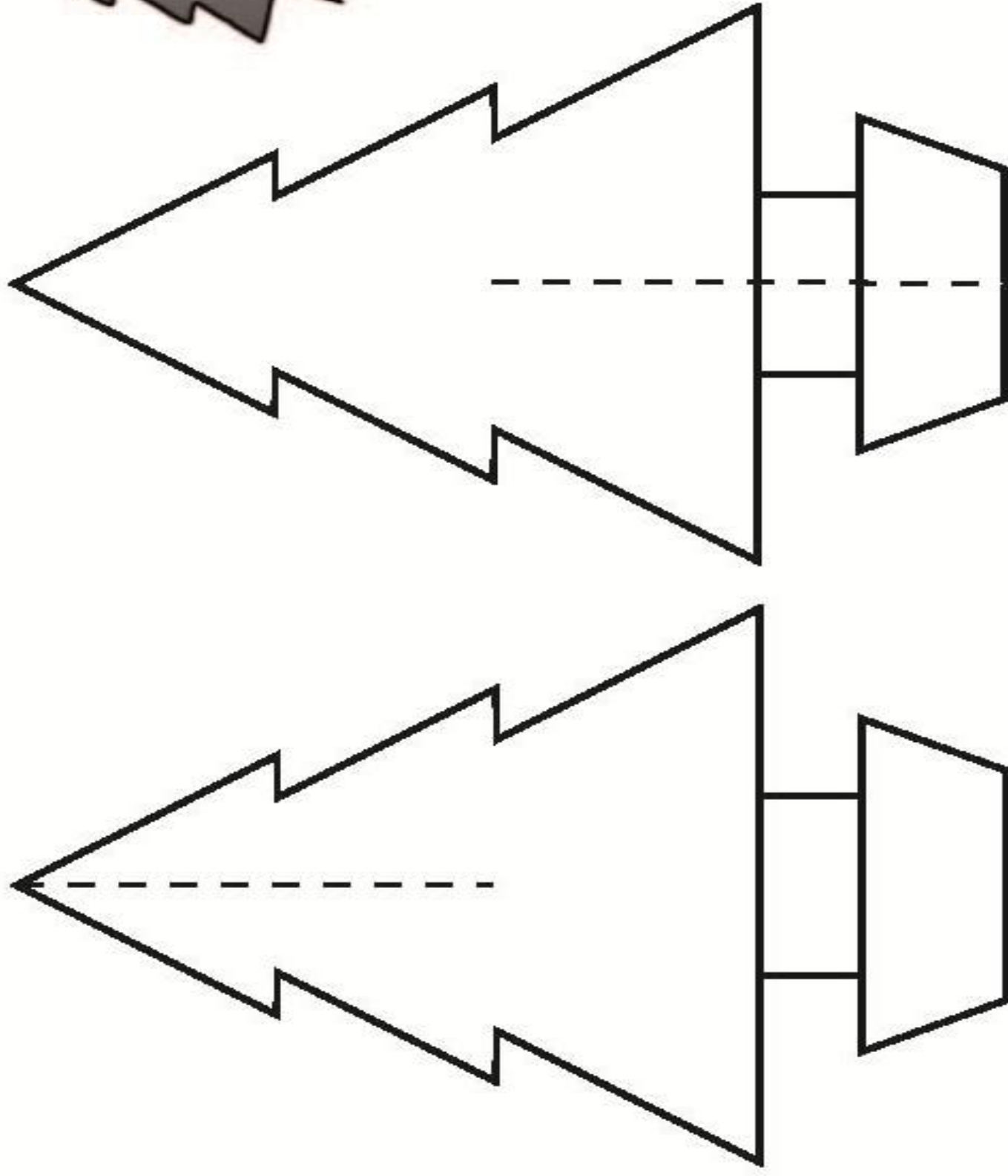


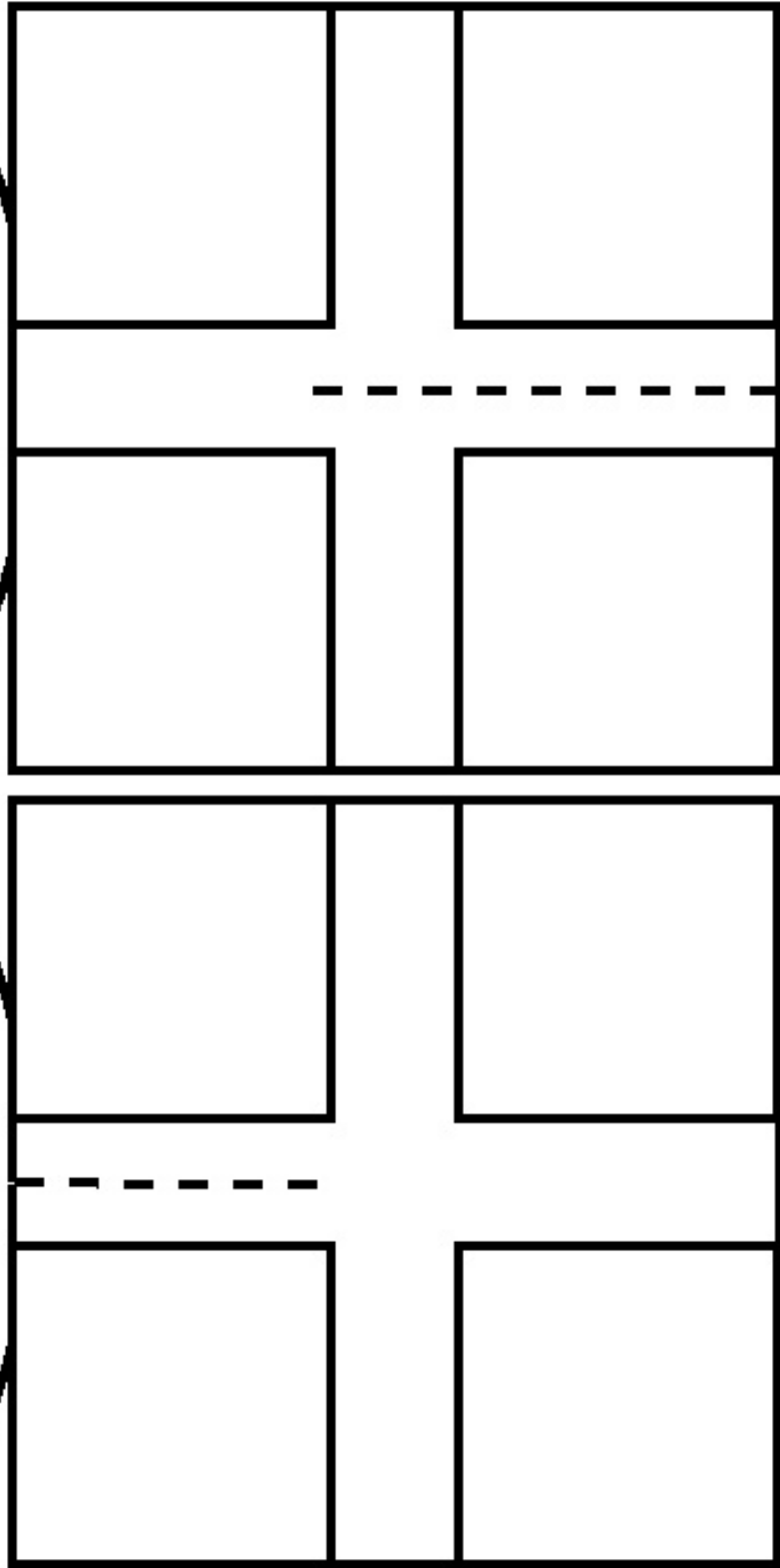

Alternatively, simply fold her in half and stand her to display, or use her as a very special Christmas card.

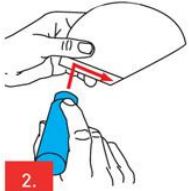

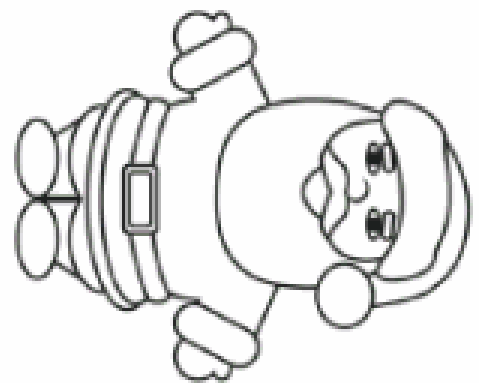
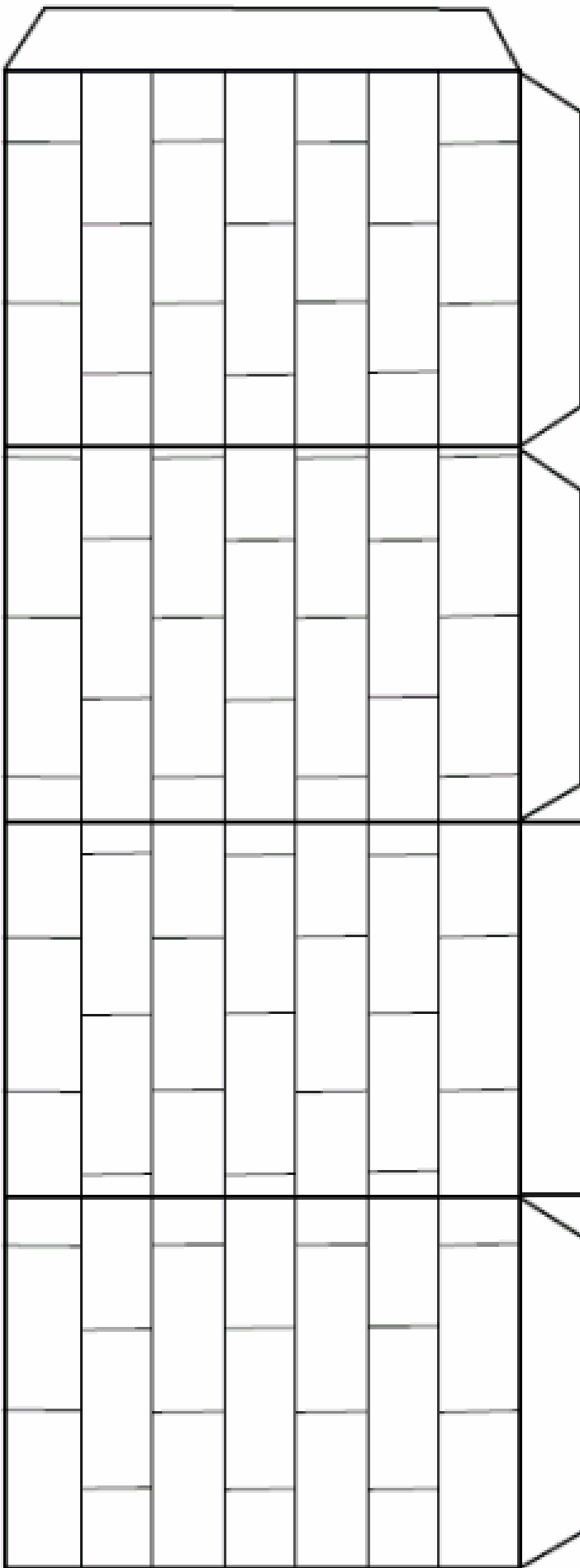
The coneopsis is made from construction paper. Silver paper may be used for lining the two sides which contain the flags.
Ribbon should not be used in construction with any construction work. Ribbon used with cardboard or paper is an inharmonious combination. It is better to use cord or even, common string. This may be colored with crayon, or soaked overnight in a tumbler containing a water-color solution.





Pop up Santa!

Colour and cut out Santa and his chimney. Fold the chimney into shape and stick together, applying glue and double sided tape to the tabs.

Attach Santa to a craft stick. Cut a small hole in the bottom of the chimney and slot the stick through the hole. Now Santa can pop out of the chimney when he has finished delivering his presents.

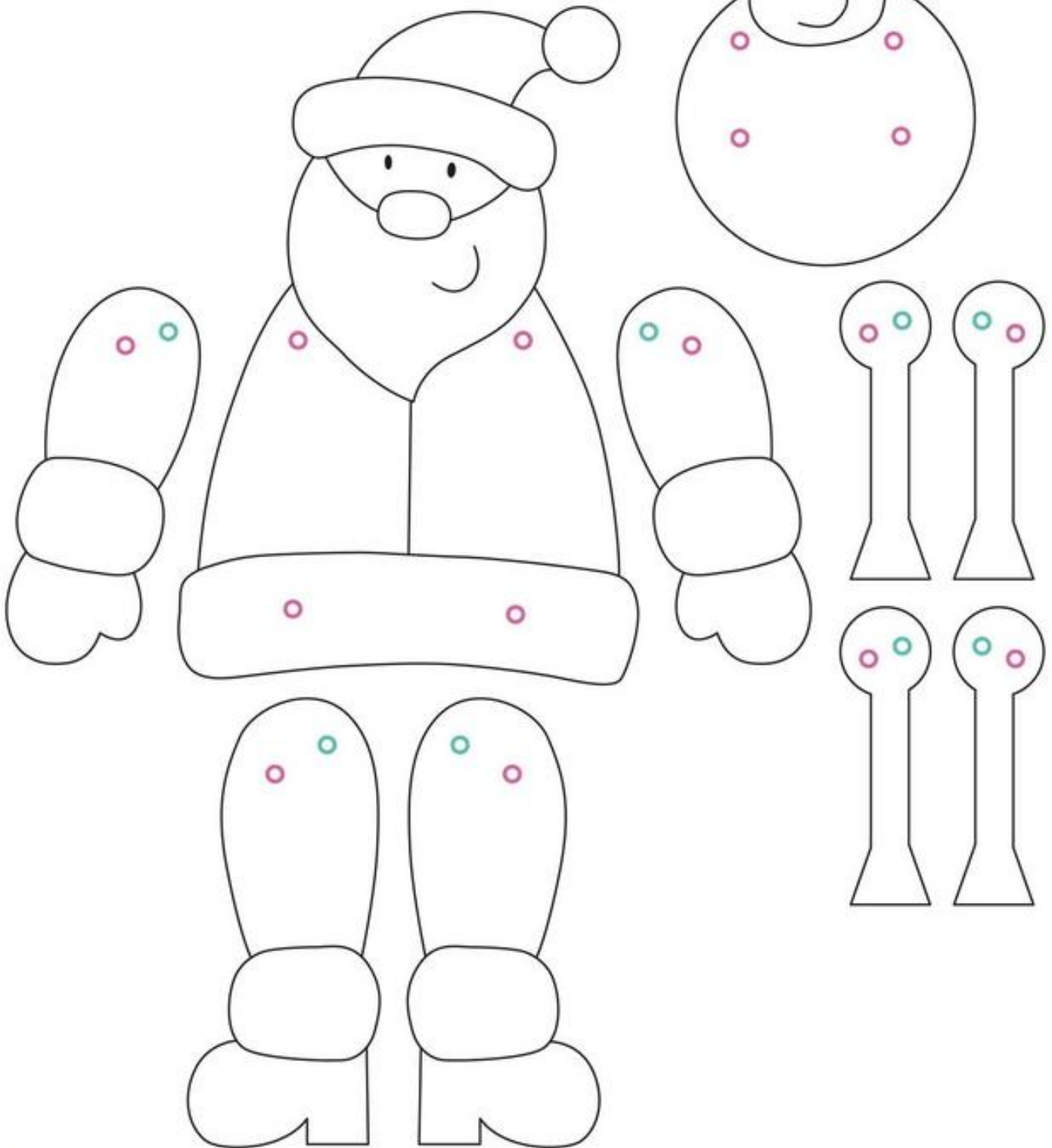
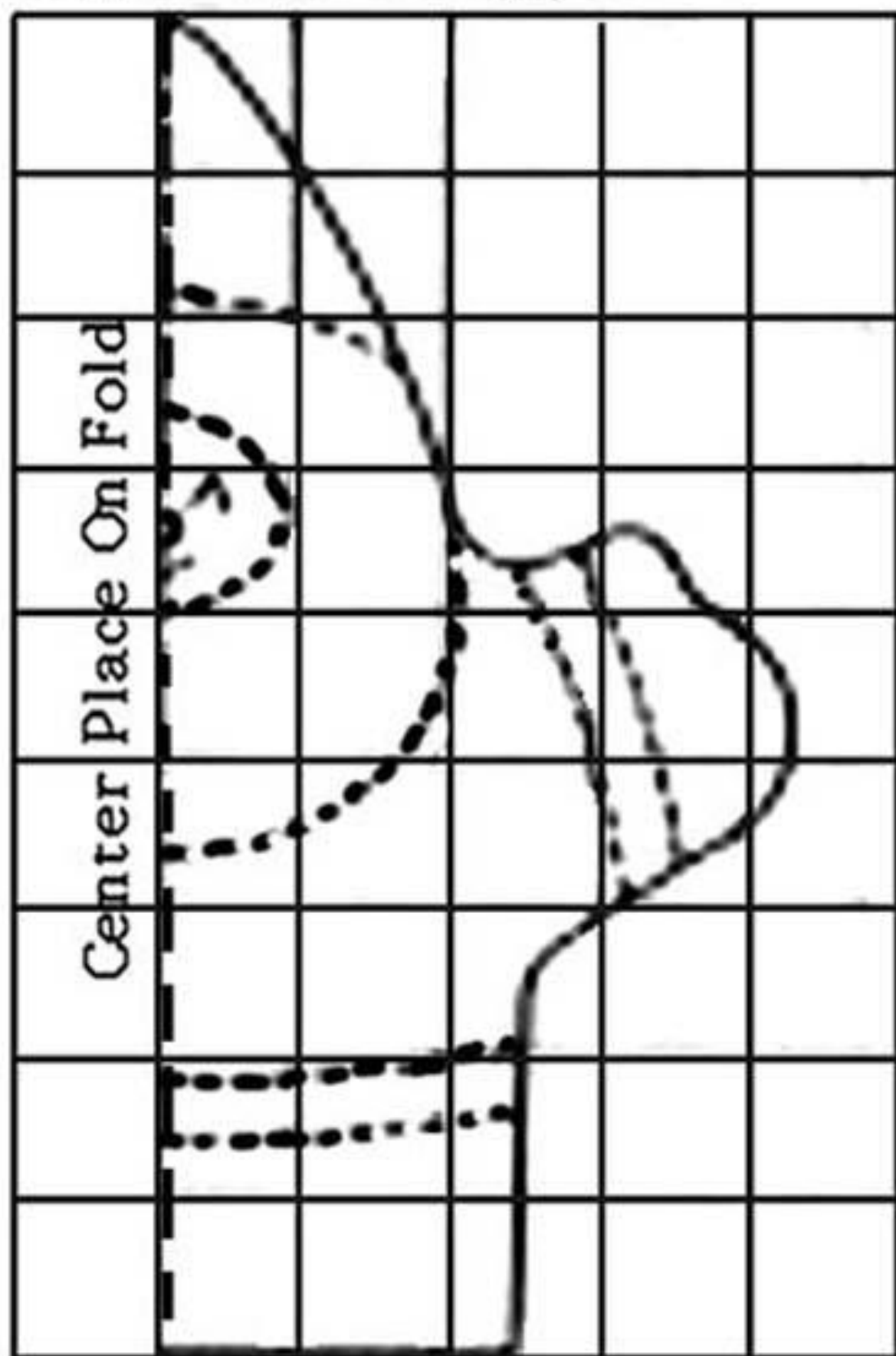
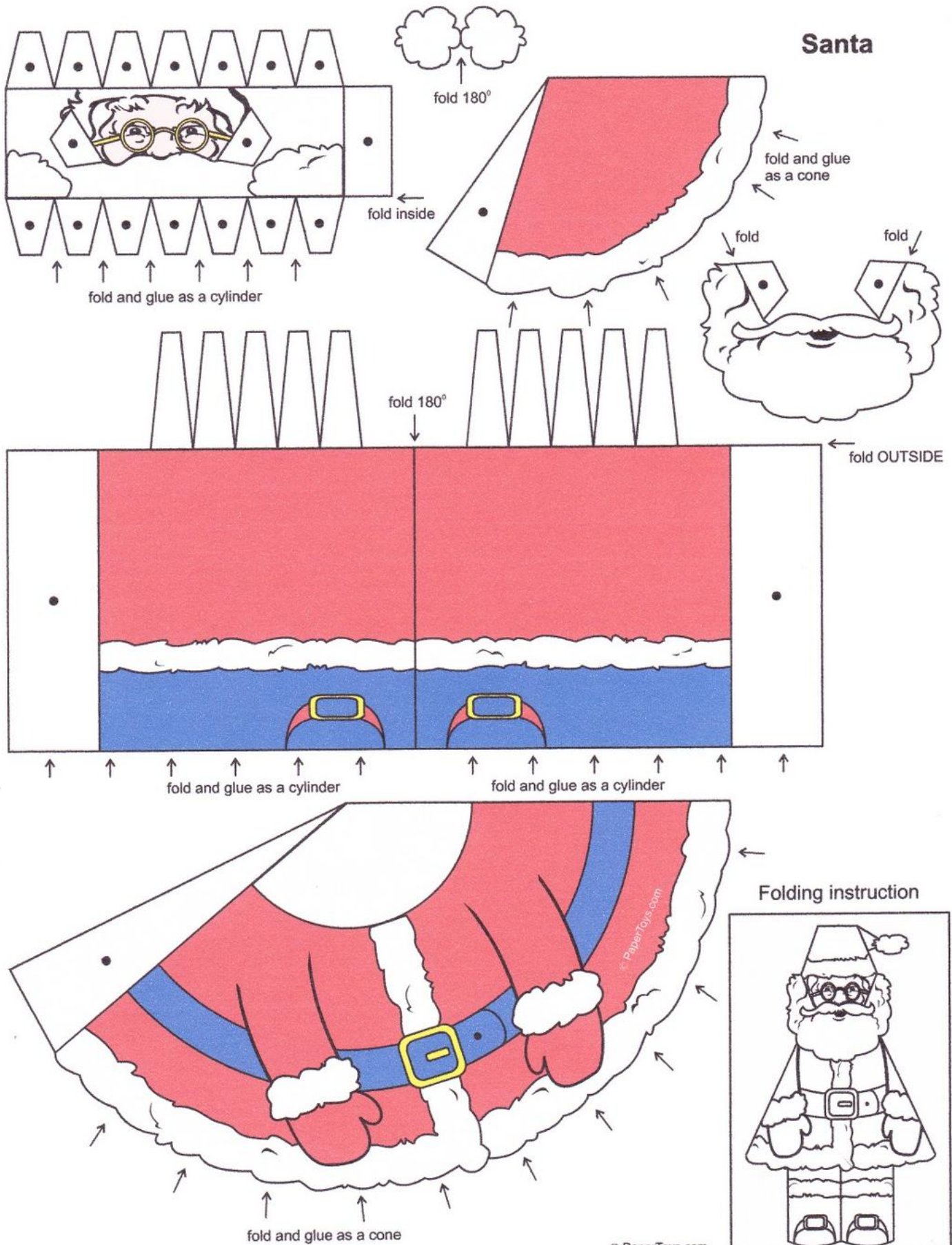


Fig 1 Hand Puppet

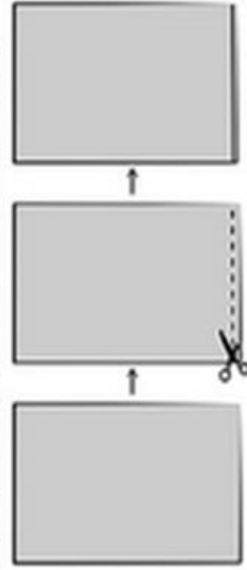
How to make the SANTA Puppet - Part One

You will need: 2 brown envelopes · 2 white envelopes · red card scrap for hat · sellotape · scissors · eyes

1. Seal all four envelopes:



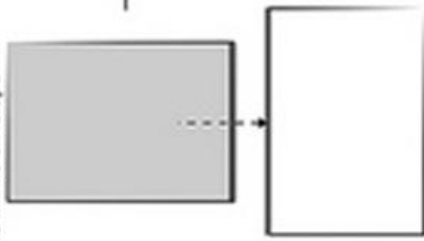
2. Cut a strip off the short edge of one brown envelope:



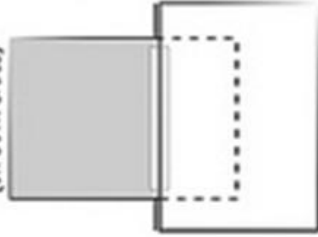
3. Cut a strip off the long edge of one white envelope:



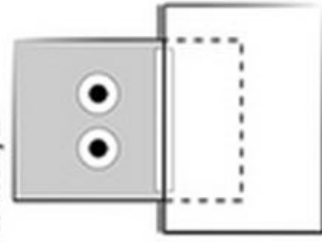
4. Slip the brown envelope just inside the white envelope:

6. Add eyes:

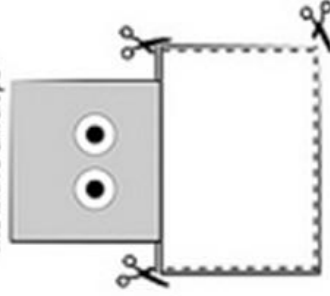

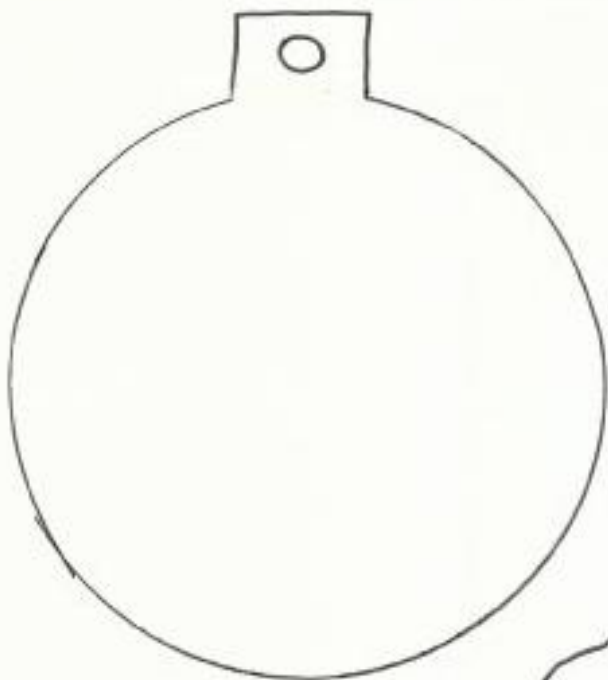
SANTA PUPPET

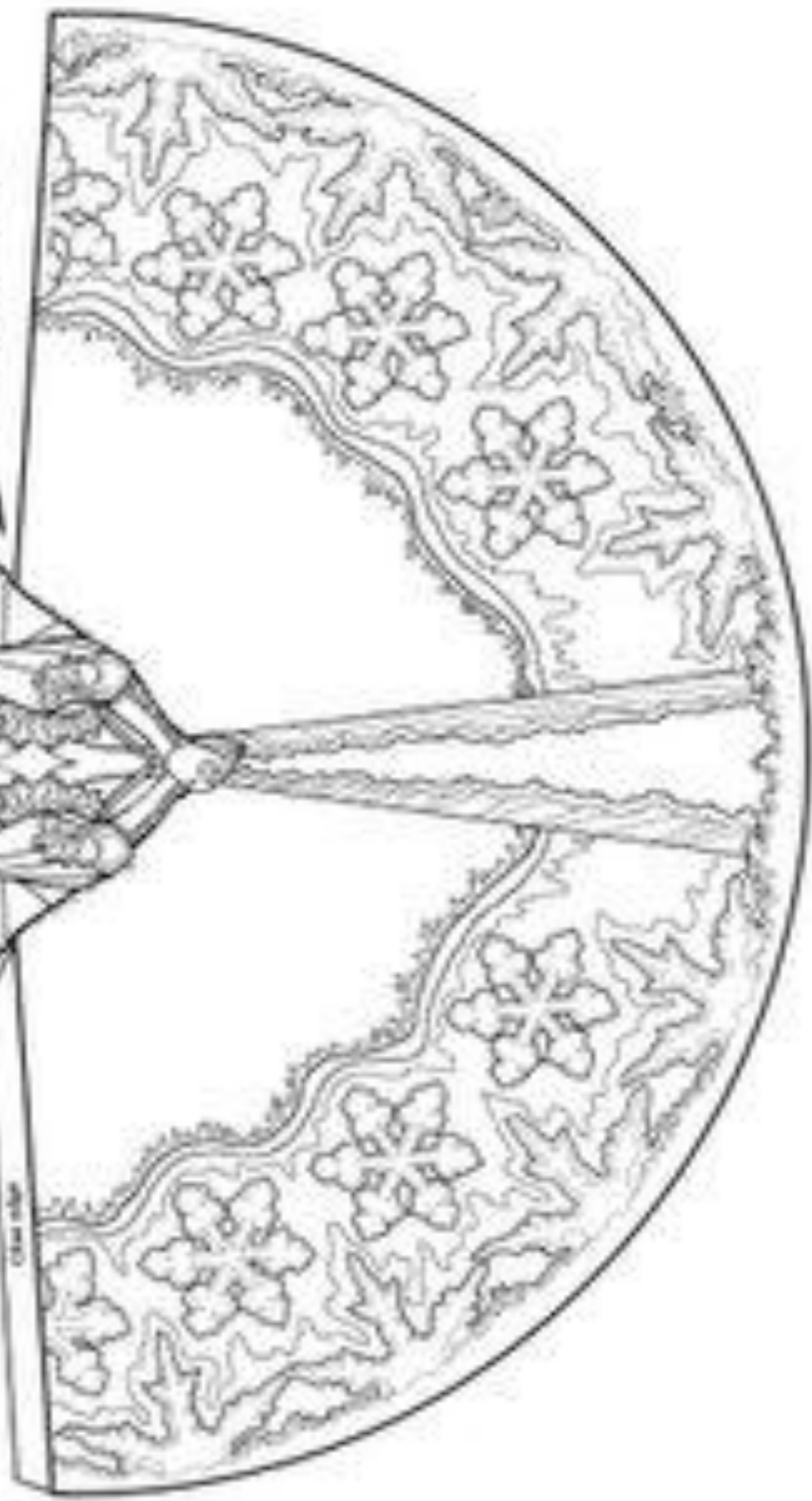

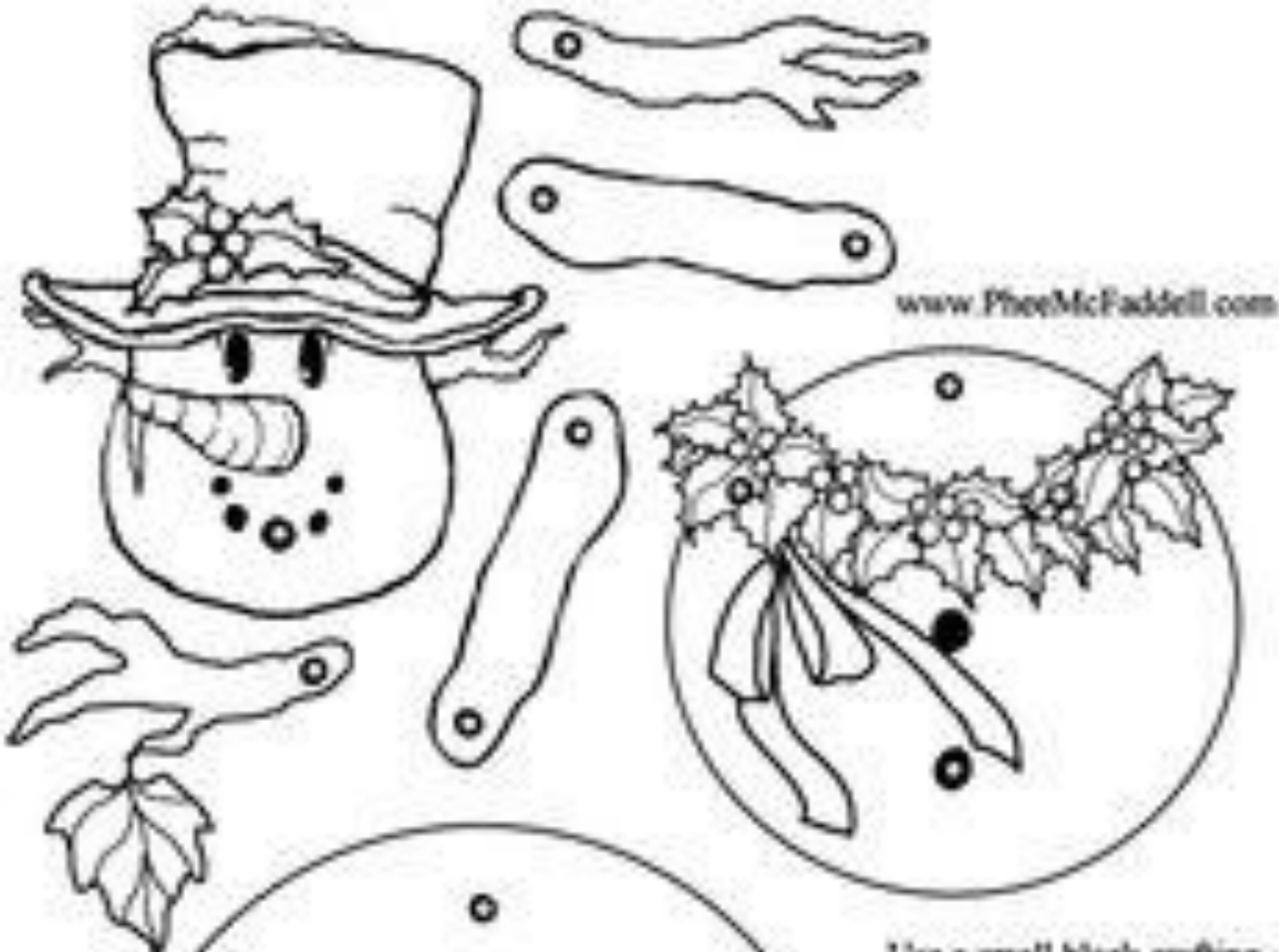

Candy Cane Snowman

SUPPLIES: Felt; white, red. Floss; white, red, lt. blue, med. blue, coral. Pipe cleaner stems; red, white. Pom poms; white. Hot glue, scissors, needle, buttons, fiberfill, wire cutter. BS=button stitch, OS=outline stitch, TS=tacking stitch

DIRECTIONS: Step 1. Cut felt pieces. Step 2. Face - OS. BS $\frac{3}{4}$ " strip around face front then back, stuffing before last stitches. Step 3. Hat-BS into cone shape. TS to head, hot glue poms. Set aside. Step 4. Body; Twist red and white pipe stems to form candy canes. Attach buttons. BS 1" strip around front body. Make small slits in strip with scissors where arms will go. Insert uncut length of pipe cleaner, trim to desired length, TS to secure to body. BS back to side strip, stuffing before last stitches. TS head to body. Step 5. OS snowflake on mitten front. BS mittens tog. Insert onto candy cane, TS to secure. Step 6. Legs-snip two small slits and insert remaining pipe cleaner cut in half to form legs, bend at ankles. TS to secure to body. Step 7. Shoes - small slit where feet will insert. BS pieces tog. Insert foot, TS to secure. Step 8. TS candy cane cording at neck. Cute as can be!
