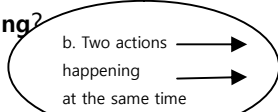
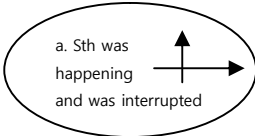
1. Simple Past

I was drinking Was I drinking?
 You were drinking Were you drinking?

KEY WORDS

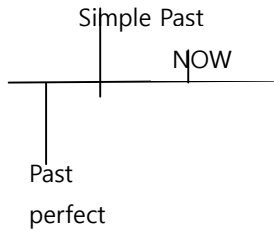
while / as / when

4. Past Perfect Continuous

I had been walking Had I been walking?

 + DURATION

I walk Do I walk?
 He walks Does he walk?

☞ Habits
 ☞ General truths

Frequency adverbs: (always/regularly/usually/often/rarely-seldom/never)
 every (week/month).../once-twice-three times a (week)

2. Present Continuous

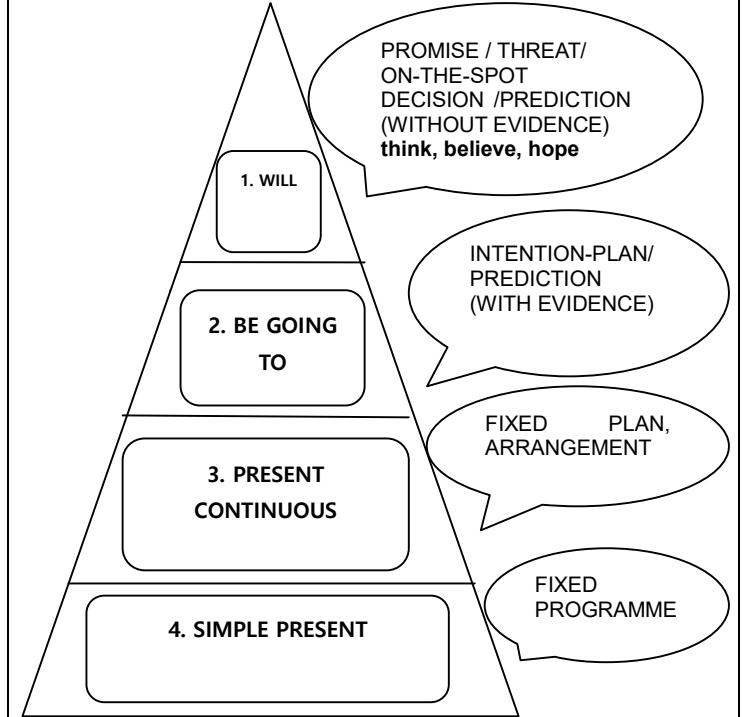
I am drinking Am I drinking?

KEY WORDS/EXPRESSIONS

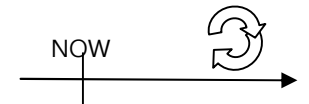
now / at the moment / at present / these days

I will have finished

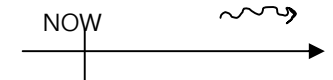


KEY WORDS
