He planned a trip as a surprise to visit their friends who live in other Greek and European places. Together they advertised their local products.



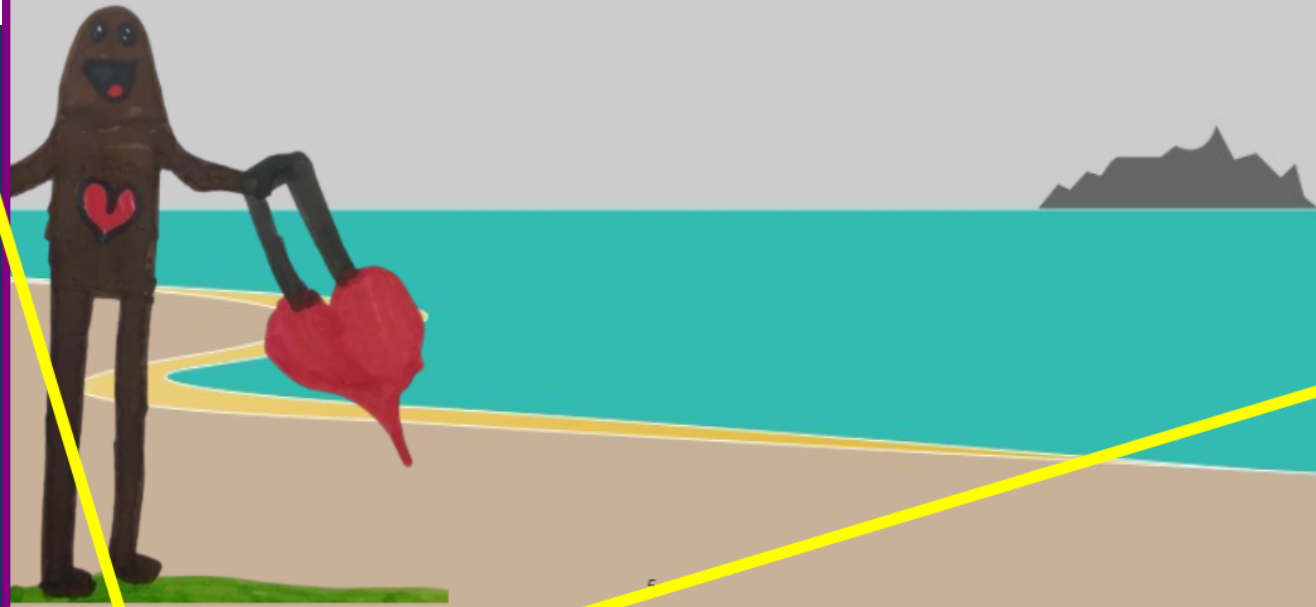
They boarded a plane, called the handsome

Samios the Pythagoras was looking forward to meet them with **Fair Cup**. Anyone could recognise Fair Cup by the blue hair and the round nose.



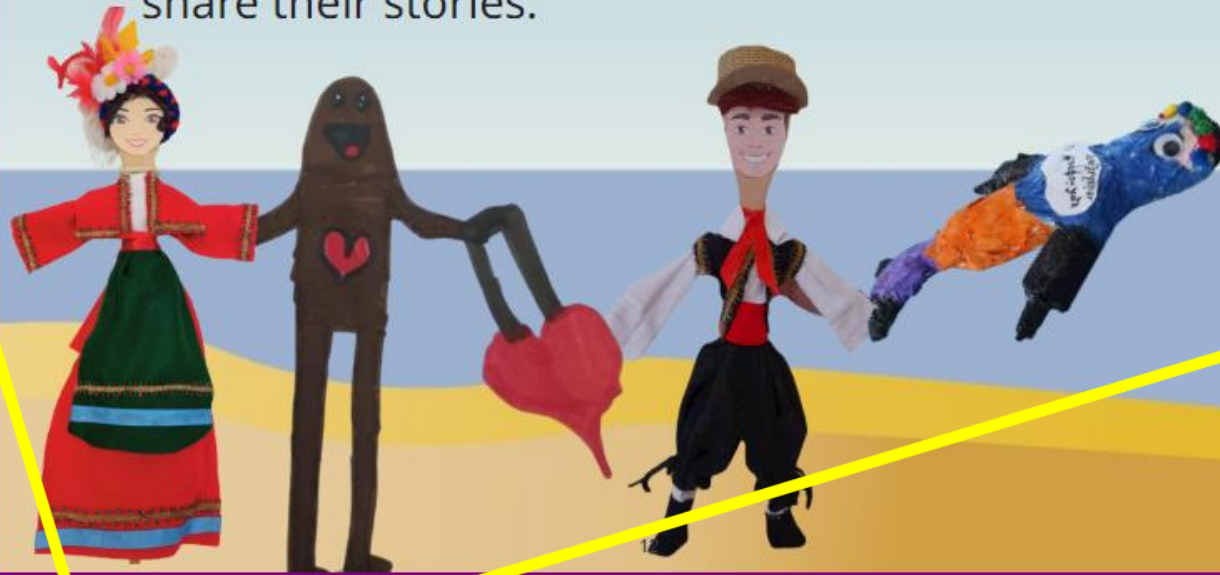
He knew a lot of secrets about nutrition which provide a lot of energy.
