The mascots were brought to life together by the students and their teachers, inspired by their wonderful ideas.




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


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


She was cooking local products in the small clay pot, called the **Tsikali**. Cretan recipes are healthy and very tasty.


Then they ate, drank and sang together. They promised to meet again soon to continue their "cooking" adventures.
