Do your plants grow with pesticides?

No, they don't grow with pesticides, they grow naturally and when necessary we use organic pesticides and manure.

Are these pesticides dangerous for the soil and water?

These pesticides are not dangerous for the soil and water because they are made from food, leftovers from people's food such as fruits and other various plants, so they are not dangerous because they are part of nature.

Do you have plants that need pesticides?

Yes, I have plants that need pesticides, but these plants are not for direct human consumption, they are either for energy or something else, so humans do not consume them.

What do you do with the leftover pesticides?

We never throw away the leftover pesticides because they are bad for the environment. We keep them in a shady and dark place so that we can use them the next time we grow crops.

Are pesticides or the natural way better?

Of course, the natural way to grow plants is better because it is a healthy way for the environment, for humans, for animals.
