Second Chance School of Komotini

Second Chance Schools (SCS) are innovative adult education public schools which aim at offering adults opportunities to re-enter the basic knowledge and skills, enhance their personality and facilitate access to the labour market. They are intended for people over 18, who have not completed the typical secondary compulsory education. The total duration of the programme is 18 months, i.e. two academic years.

The weekly programme consists of 25 teaching hours and the courses take place in the evening, from Monday to Friday. Upon successful completion of the course, a degree equivalent to that of typical education is awarded. This degree entitles them to register with the Unified Lyceum, Technical Vocational Educational Institutes or attend certain vocational training courses.

Second Chance Schools' curriculum differs from that of typical education. The content is more flexible and collaborative learning, the method of project as well as cross-curricular approaches are considered to be the most appropriate teaching and learning methods.

The subjects that are taught are the following:

- Greek Language
- Mathematics
- English Language
- Information Technology
- Social Education
- Environmental Studies
- Physical Sciences
- Cultural Aesthetic Education

Second Chance Schools (SCS), which were established in Greece (law 2525/97), are part of the European programme aiming to fight social exclusion.
