The **main target of this game**, was for children to learn the right ways to manage the use of water and also • to use that ways in their every day home activities.

Instructions

2-4 players

First of all, you need to place the cards with face up.

Then you roll the dice and you move forward as many squares as the number of dice.

Then, if our pawn lands on a picture, we starting a discussion about it and we have to decide if the picture is a good way or not to manage water waste.

To confirm our assumption, we have to find the same card and read the text from the back.

The one that reaches the Finish line first, wins!
