**THE "RED" DEER**


- It lives in many places in the world. It lives in Europe, Asia and North America. In winter, deer live in forests. In summer, they go to the mountains. There is more food there.
- In Greece they live in Parnitha, **Rhodopi** and Epirus. Today, there are not many deer in Greece, about 600 animals still live!
- People hunt deer. This is a big problem. Fires can also hurt deer and destroy their homes and food.

**"Did you know?"**

- Deer are the biggest plant-eating animals in Greece.
- They have antlers! Only male deer have antlers. Antlers grow again every year.
- In summer, they are red brown, but in winter, they are grey.
- A deer lives about 12-15 years.
- It weighs up to 300 kilos
- Its length is about 1 and a half to 2 and a half metres long and it is about 1 and a half metres high!
- In May or June, the female deer gives birth to a baby. The baby is a fawn.

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**THE OTTER**


- The Eurasian (European and Asian) otter is a small animal that lives on the banks of rivers and lakes, and only where the water is very clean.
- In Greece there is an otter population in **central Greece** and some smaller populations in **Corfu** and in **Evia**.
- The otters diet consists of 80% of fish, but also of **amphibians** (frogs), **birds** and **small animals**.
- Dangers:** the rivers and lakes are polluted! **Hydroelectric** dams. The destruction of the vegetation in lakes and rivers and the flooding of its natural habitat. All these **result** from human activity.

**"Did you know?"**

- Otters have long, slim bodies, powerful webbed feet for swimming, and their dense fur, which keeps them warm in water. They are playful animals, they like sliding and playing with stones.
- They can live up to 16 years.
- It gives birth to a small baby that stays with its parents for about a year!
- The otter needs fresh water to clean its fur. It **spends** a lot of time **daily** to care for its fur.
- The nest is in a tunnel.
- It usually hunts during the night and in lakes and rivers and the flooding of its natural habitat. All these result from human activity.
- It sees, hears and smells very well, outside and inside of the water!



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**Kri-kri wild goat**

- It lives only in Greece, in **Lasithi** Ori (white mountains) and the **Samaria** gorge in Crete, on the island of **Thodorou** and in Athens National Garden. Also known as the Cretan goat or agriotti!
- Its colour is light brown and grey.
- Its population is about 700 animals. The males have got horns!
- Hunting is a problem (that is also human activity) and droughts (for their food).


**"Did you know?"**

- It is about 1 and a half metres long, and about 80 cm to 95 cm tall!
- Females weigh from 25 to 55 kilos and males from 45 to 90 kilos!
- It eats tree leaves and plants!
- Females give birth to 1 or 2 kids in spring!
- It lives for 11 to 12 years!

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**The golden Jackal**

- It lives in Europe (mostly the Balkans), in Asia and Africa.
- In Greece it lives in east Macedonia and Thrace, **Thessaly**, **Eubolia**, Peloponnese, Samos, and in **Xerolita** lake and Axios river.
- It eats plants and fruit and small animals: frogs, fish, snails, mice, rabbits, insects, birds, but also sheep and goats.
- The jackal is mentioned in the Greek and Egyptian mythology!
- The jackal population is about 1.500 animals.
- Dangers:** people hunt it and fires destroy their natural habitat (home).


**"Did you know?"**

- The Jackal cleans nature because it eats dead animals!
- It has very good hearing and smell.
- Its nest is between rocks, or it takes other animals' nests!
- It gives birth to 3 to 6 babies.
- It is about 1 metre long and it weighs about 15 kilos!
- They live up to 8 to 12 years.
- The colour of its fur is open brown or yellow/golden!
