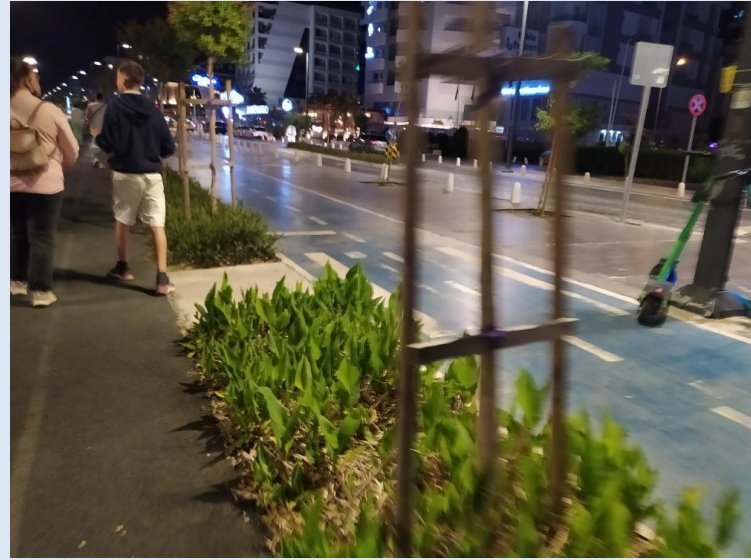

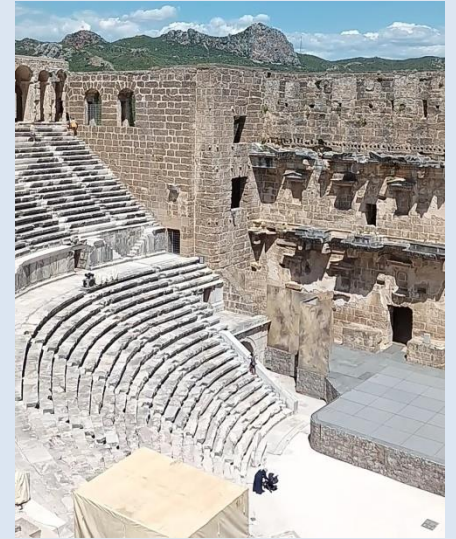
MONDAY, MAY 9th

TUESDAY, MAY 10th

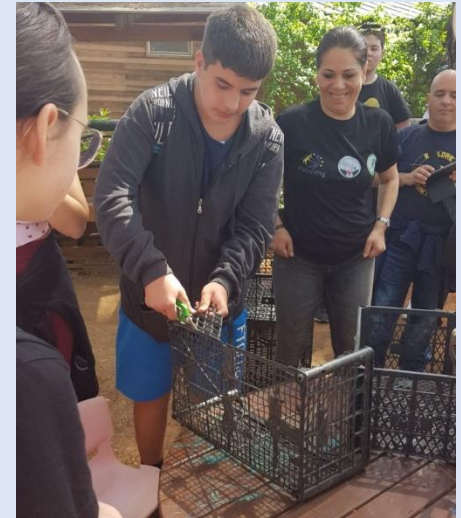


Second day
