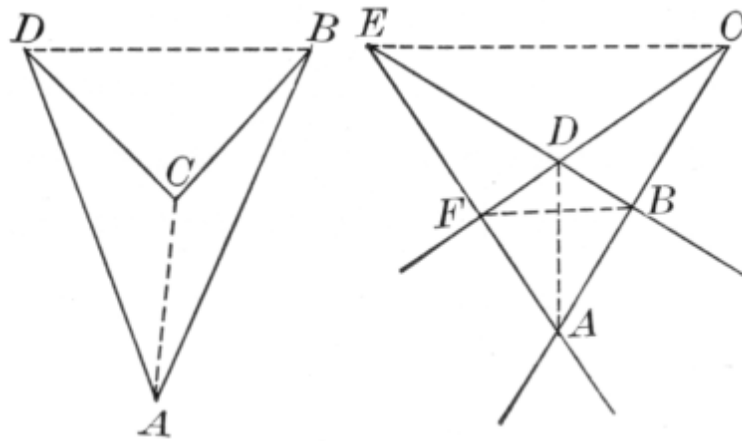

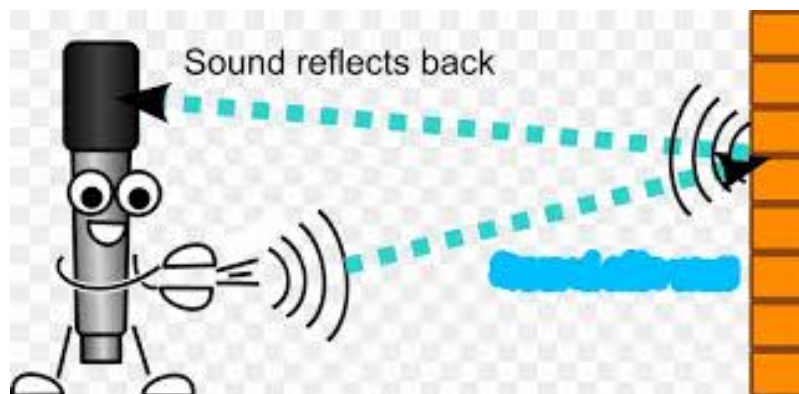


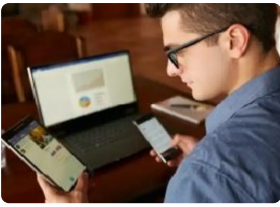

- the part of the phone that you hold in your hand and speak into

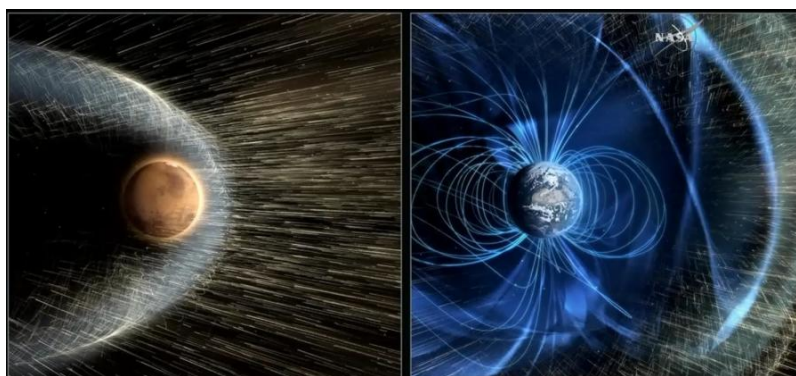


## photo - φωτογραφία
