

Winnie and Paddington: the two beloved bears


First, there was one famous teddy bear whose name was Winnie-the-Pooh! He was very much loved by a little boy, who lived in England in the 1920s. The boy's name was Christopher Milne. His father, A.A. Milne was an English author who wrote about Winnie-the-Pooh and his books were published to become very much loved by English children and adults. Later, when Winnie-the-Pooh appeared as a Walt Disney character he became famous all over the world, as Winnie-the-Pooh books were translated in many languages.

The day before Christmas, 1956, another Englishman by the name of Michael Bond bought the only teddy bear left in a London department store. He gave it to

his wife and named it 'Paddington' because they lived near Paddington Station. He too wrote about the teddy bear and became a famous author! His first book, A Bear Called Paddington, was followed by many more – charming people with Paddington's good intentions and the many humorous situations he is in. In the next 50 years, and more than 50 million books later, Paddington is known throughout the world! Paddington books have been translated in many languages, from Hebrew to Latin!

Two of the world's greatest explorers



Sir Richard Francis Burton was a British explorer, geographer, diplomat, writer and translator. He spoke 29 European, Asian and African (**16a**) _____! He was famous for his (**17a**) _____ and explorations in Asia, Africa and the Americas. He was a captain in the army, serving India and later in the Crimean War. He was a fellow of the Royal Georgaphical Society and was awarded as a knight in 1886.



Nelly Bly (pseudonym of Elizabeth Cochran) was a journalist: the first newspaper woman in U.S. history. Her first articles were about working (**18a**) _____ and women in her city, Pittsburgh. Then, she wrote about rich politicians and poor (**19a**) ____ in Mexico. In 1878 she moved to New York and worked for Pulitzer's "New York World" and, on 14th November 1889, she sailed from New York for her adventurous journey. Butterfly lovers...

This is a Chinese legend that tells a tragic story between a pair of lovers: Liang and Zhu. Their love story is the Chinese version of Romeo and Juliet. It (21a) <u>happened</u> in the Eastern Jin Dynasty (317–420).

In order to get higher education, Zhu (22a) <u>disguised</u> herself as a man and went to study in the Hangzhou Academy, far away from home. There she met Liang, a scholar from another town. They studied together for the next three years and (23a) got to be best friends, but Zhu fell in love with Liang, who didn't know that Zhu was a woman.

Chinese New Year Celebrations with dragon and lion dances

The Chinese New Year is celebrated in China and in many other Asian countries such as Korea, Japan, Vietnam, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand and Indonesia. Additionally, it is popular in the Chinatowns of big cities in other countries —cities (26a) _____ New York, London, Vancouver and Sydney.




