It is surrounded by sea all along its length and it is the most beautiful part of the "Athenian Riviera". It has 50.000 inhabitants and it is one of the most luxurious and beautiful suburbs of Greece!

OUR BEAUTIFUL SEA AND BEACHES



Our city has beautiful and popular beaches. Some of them are free of charge while others are private. They all have been awarded with the "blue flag" sign for the quality of both the crystal clear water and the sandy beaches. Most of them have canteens, bars and some of them have special ramp for helping people with disabilities to access the sea.

On the organized beaches one may find football fields, beach volley or tennis courts and plenty of water sports such as banana, water ski, windsurfing and many more. During the summer months, kids-summercamps, concerts, theme-parties and various tournaments are usually organized there as well.

Vouliagmeni Lake




Lake Vouliagmeni is considered a real treasure, in the center of our City. It is a rare geological phenomenon in an idyllic landscape. The brackish Water of the Lake is constantly renewed both from the sea and plenty underground thermal springs that promise a natural and unique Thermal Spa experience!

It includes a complex underwater cave with 14 tunnels. In Vouliagmeni Lake one can find a rare species of sea-anemone as well as the unique "garra rufa" fish that offers perfect skin exfoliation.

Around the lake there is an organized area for swimming as well as a luxurious restaurant bar & a beautiful event-venue.

SQUARES AND PARKS



In our municipality there are many squares. Some of them are large and crowded with plenty of shops while others are small and quite. They are all green and neat.

The one closest to our school includes a skate Park and is next to the sea. It is the place we visit with our school on our school walks. There are many other smaller or larger parks around the neighborhoods or at the central points of our city. In some of them one may find monuments, statues, playgrounds, trees, flowers and bushes.

Ancient Sites



Our area has been inhabited since the ancient times. Thus, excavations have brought several ancient monuments to light. During the renovation of popular "Kavouri" beach in 2013 an important part of an ancient street for carriages was discovered. An important cemetery with graves and tombs has also been discovered that goes back to the 5th and the 4th century B.C. The name of the region Vari is owed to this cemetery as the word "var" means grave in an old dialect of this area.

Out of the rest of the archaeological sites, the temple of Apollo stands out. It is located by the sea in the luxurious area of the Astir Palace Hotel which was also visited by the students of Alphington Grammar school during their last visit to Greece (see photo)

Restaurants – Cafes - Bars



Our city is full of cafes, restaurants and bars, many of which are situated by the sea and are extremely luxurious. One can taste a variety of flavors from all over the world: greek and italian cuisine as well as mexican and asian food, however fresh fish as well as mediterranean cuisine are the most dominant ones. Especially during the summer all restaurants are full of people and our city is considered one of the most popular destinations in Athens.

There are also 3 cinemas in our city: our summer open Cinemas are among the most beautiful in Greece!





- 3. The street race "Run the Lake" is a famous Sporting event of our municipality. About 2000 to 3000 people participate and is carried out on the most beautiful Route of our country in Vouliagmeni!
- 4. The "Winter swimming DIAPLUS of Vouliagmeni" is carried out ever in November at the magical golf of our city.
