

## To all members and followers of the EAAE activities,

With this publication the EAAE informs all members and followers of the activities of the European Association for Astronomy Education that will announce its two emblematic competitions: Catch a Star and Space Art on the scheduled dates.

Firstly, the call for the *Catch a Star* contest will be published <u>on November 1, 2023 and the deadline for participants to send their works will end on March 31, 2024</u>.

The *Space Art* contest will be called on <u>January 2, 2024 and the deadline to submit works and participate</u> will be March 31, 2024. The resolution of the contest will be announced on April 22.

There will be no significant changes in the rules and requirements to participate, as well as in the prizes awarded. In order for the projects to maintain their high success rate, we ask them to give maximum dissemination to the announcements of the two competitions among their contacts: professional networks, personal contacts, teachers' associations, schools, publications in educational magazines in their respective countries and by any other means possible at your disposal.
